The Herald reached out to SBC for additional information but did not hear back from school officials prior to publication. West said he was enjoying being an every day player for the school and being a part of its inaugural baseball team.

Kole Kittrell, a member of the GCHS Class of 2017, rode a 2-year sting at Gulf Coast Community College to an opportunity at Delta State where he is in his second year with the Statesmen. He made eight relief appearances for Delta State before last season was halted by the pandemic.

He had nine strikeouts to his credit through 7.1 innings at the time and did not allow a run in five of his eight relief appearances. He has seen limited action in the Statesmen's first six games, but is expected to be an important piece of the DSU pitching staff as the season progresses.
