

Warrants have been issued charging Kentavius Stefan Mills, age 30, of Heath Springs, with Attempted Murder and Possession of a Firearm during



Sheriff's Office is investigating a Crime. Mills has been in a shooting that occurred at a relationship with an adult female with whom he shared his home. The female's father and brother A little after 7:00 p. m. live at the Green Peach Road home. The female went to her father's home late yesterday after a disagreement with Mills. Mills followed, and a confrontation occurred outside the home between Mills, the female's father, and her brother, the victim. Mills is said to have fired several shots, and the victim was struck by gunfire. The female and two young children were inside the other information about the home when the shooting occurred. No other injuries were reported.

> Mills fled the scene. Mills is a black male standing 5' 10" tall and weighing 150 pounds. He should be considered armed and dangerous. Anyone who spots Mills should immediately call or 911 or contact the sheriff's office. Mills should not be approached. His photograph is attached.
