They stepped up to be assistants and have always been there for the team when they are needed. They love the team, the community, and Dresden. Looking at the team, the defense this year is strong.

Ritz said the team is starting to get the idea of being physical and playing hard. But he also said it is a struggle to get some of the younger kids learning that it is not the football they used to play when they were younger, and they need to learn that. However, the defensive line is shaping up with Jaqwan Ellison, who is a key player, returning on the field. Brody Taylor and Gabe Alverez are two more strong players that Ritz said need to be looked out for this season. The linebacker positions were what a lot of younger players were hoping to earn during the time of the interview. Luke DiPietro, and Bruce Willis. Ritz noted they are good players as long as they keep coming and stay focused. Both sides of the ball are bringing different challengers to the team this year. With a new coaching staff, the system of playing has changed to what they were used to last year.

The team used to work to hold back the defensive line, but this year Richard Ritz wants the offense to be more focused on spreading out and throwing the ball more. Helping with this is quarterback Luke DiPietro, who is returning as a good player and leader for the team.

Jaqwan Ellison and Brody Taylor will also be on the offensive line, and they are really smart on the field.

Ritz said this about DiPietro, If he can play the way that he thinks he can play, it will be really up to him on how far we go this year. Two others who will be carrying the team a lot this season are offense linemen Brody Taylor and Jaqwan Ellison. Cooper Allman will have a lot of work running the ball and so far, all four of them have been doing very well." The Lions' special teams were being considered at the time of the interview, but there were no players named for those positions. Ritz said they did not have a kicker and were looking to see who would play the best for that position. The team is looking well overall for the start of the season. Ritz went on to say that everyone is on the same slate with a new system and coaching staff and its like they have 30 new guys. The team is on the right path this year and working to make sure that their fun and excitement transfers to the field to win. COVID has affected Dresden Middle like it has many teams, having to miss a lot of valuable snaps and plays. Younger players have also not come back out to play for the middle school like they were expected to and there are lower numbers than what they expected. Ritz stressed it will be up to the parents on helping their kids out.


