Gleason High School head football coach Noah Lampkins said his team has been working on building confidence in the off-season as the Bulldogs look to the upcoming season.

Lampkins said they are looking for big things from returning player, senior Isaac Denton, who was one of the best handling the ball last season. Denton will take on the position of running back.

Sophomore Drake Lovell also rounds out the starting line on offense, alongside quarterback and senior Kolton Crotchet. With

Lovell as one of the primary ball carriers for the Bulldogs, Lampkins said they are looking to give junior Kyle Brewer and senior Carson Tidwell lots of space.

"We're going to try and use Crotchet's size and athletic ability to get him running down the hill," Lampkins shared.

Junior Austin Clark will also have his hands on the ball as running back for the team.

Tidwell was complimented with his 7-on-7 action this summer after catching well for the

Lampkins said they will look to Tidwell as primary receiver, along with Hagen Hodges' skill protecting the ball.

"We have a lot of kids really step as seniors and senior athletes. We've worked really hard in the weight room and seen pretty consistent participation this summer," Lampkins said.

The head coach said they are working on being more confident, as well as competitive. Lampkins said confidence in winning and avoiding negativity after mistakes will carry the players throughout the season.


