**#30 BILLY BRANNAN** (6'0", 208 lb., TE/DL) "He just came on in the spring. He said that he was interested in playing football. Billy wants to learn the game. He jumps in on any drill whether it is scout team drill or varsity drill. It does not matter — he will jump in the huddle and try to get his reps. He wants to be a part of this team and he really wants to contribute."

**#33 BRYCE CURRIE** (5'10", 206 lb., RB/LB) "Bryce is one of our dogs. He is one of our team leaders. We just need to see a little bit more consistency out of his leadership skills. But, other than that, there is no question that Bryce is one of our top guys."

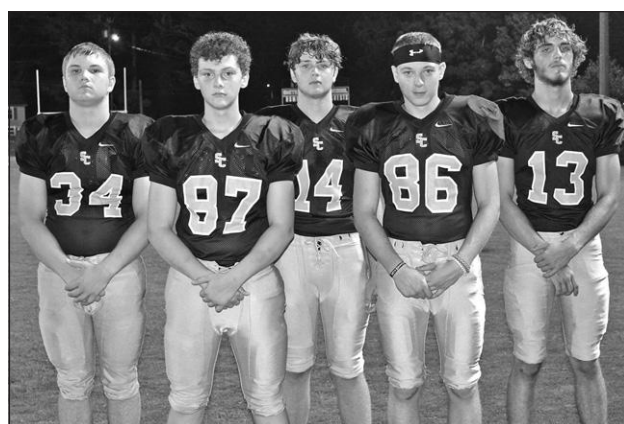
"Defensively, he is a returning starting linebacker. He was a Co-Linebacker of the Region last year — he had over 100 tackles. He has a nose for the football. He is a physical kid who works hard in the weight room. He gets everyone lined up. He calls coverages and calls fronts. He has a very high football IQ. He is just a hard nosed and old-fashioned kid. He moves very well. He really tries to fine tune his craft in practice. He is the type of guy who hates to lose and refuses to lose. He holds other guys accountable. He is a true football player. Offensively, he is going to help us some in the backfield. He has probably taken his first hand-off ever this season in the backfield. He has performed in that role very well. So, we will look for him to carry the ball for us."

**#58 JIMMY ENOCH** (6'4", 279 lb., OL/DL) "Jimmy is one of our bigger guys. We are looking to move him to center this year to kind of direct that offensive line. I believe he is a two year starter coming back. He brings a lot of experience to that offensive line."

**#61 JEREMIAH RESTREPO** (5'6", 235 lb., OL/DL) "We just have to have more consistency out of Jeremiah. He does have some attendance issues. We just have to correct that and get him on the field. He could help us. When he is here, he is dialed in — he is working. But, the problem with Jeremiah is we just have to get him here more often."

**#71 JAMISON KEELEY** (6'0", 230 lb., OL/DL) "We call him 'Bubba' — that is his nickname. There is not many people on this team that can compete with Jamison. There is not many people on many teams that can compete with 'Bubba'. Jamison he just has to decide when he is going to turn it on. He has to decide when he is going to perform and when he decides that he wants to perform — no one is going to out perform him. He is very physical and a strong kid. He is probably one of the more athletic kids on the team. He plays guard for us and plays a little tackle and end for us. He has got to be more consistent in his attitude and effort. He could be an unstoppable force and immovable object when he wants to be."

**#72 DANE WOODARD** (6'9", 355 lb., OL/DL) "He is the biggest kid on the team and the strongest kid on the team. He moves very well. He is injured right now. He hurt his knee back in spring practice. He had to have surgery on it. Right now, we are just waiting to see when he can return. He has been doing his physical therapy. Like I said, we have been a plug and play, next man up team and we found that out quick. Dane, going into his junior year, has struck some adversity. He has answered it very well. He has done a good job with his physical therapy and they have given him a projection that he could possibly be back mid-season for us and that would really help us out."

**#8 JOE DANIEL STOUT** (5'7", 283 lb., OL/DL) "He is another one who is a hard worker. I think he actually works with Hayden Bush in his landscaping business. He shows up every day. I do not think he has missed a single day. He has a high motor and he is an asset to have on both the offensive and defensive lines."

**#87 NATHEN DAVIS** (5'8", 150 lb., TE/LB) "Nathen right now is a backup linebacker for us. He has gotten a few reps in the two scrimmages we have had. Nathen is a guy who shows up everyday and works his hardest. He is going to have to be a guy who can give some rest reps to some of those linebackers when they need it."

### SOPHOMORES

Coach Dyer highlighted some of the Owls' 25-member sophomore class — the largest class on the team. Several of these players could see playing time this season after being utilized some last season as freshmen.

**#6 KEY HARRIS** (5'4", 115 lb., WR/DB) "Key is not a very big kid but he is very cerebral and very smart. He gets the secondary lined up. He has made it his goal that he will refuse to be on the sideline. He has made it very impossible for us coaches to not have him on the field even being a sophomore. He gets the secondary lined up and he makes the calls for them. He has played his way into a starting position."

**#7 KYLAN JOHNSON** (6'2", 150 lb., WR/DB) "Kylan Johnson is another one who is a very athletic kid. Possibly the fastest kid on the team. We are just trying to figure out more ways that we can get him the football on offense. He plays as one of our running backs or a wingback. On defense,

he is our free safety. He is our center fielder back there. He is a baseball guy who can cover a lot of ground. He does not mind getting his nose down in the thick of it and getting physical. He is a great kid."

**#10 PEYTON HIX** (6'0", 205 lb., TE/LB) "Peyton Hix started last year at linebacker as a freshman. He is going to play linebacker again for us this year as a sophomore. He is going to start for us as a tight end for us too. He has really embraced his role as a tight end and he has improved in that since the spring and since the summer. He does a really good job at linebacker too. He and Bryce Currie really anchor that front seven down. So, we will look for great things from Peyton."

**#12 RYNE MARTIN** (5'9", 175 lb., RB/LB) "He is a backup wingback for us. Kind of a fullback, that we will end up using him. Ryne just has to improve his football IQ. He just has to start paying more attention to what we are doing and how he can get involved and get on the field more. We talk about consistency a lot and he is one of those who just has to increase his consistency."

**#13 JAY PHILLIPS** (6'0", 165 lb., TE/DB) "He started last year as a freshman as well in the secondary. Jay is a physical type player at safety. He will come up and he will lay a lien. He will put the hat on you. We are expecting good things out of him. He will come up and set the edge for us on defense."

**#17 RILEY LOLLAR** (5'10", 185 lb., TE/LB) "Riley has carved out a starting role on defense at our 'Jack' position — it is kind of like an outside linebacker for us. He works really hard in the weight
