Vernon opens district play on Friday as they host Burkburnett.

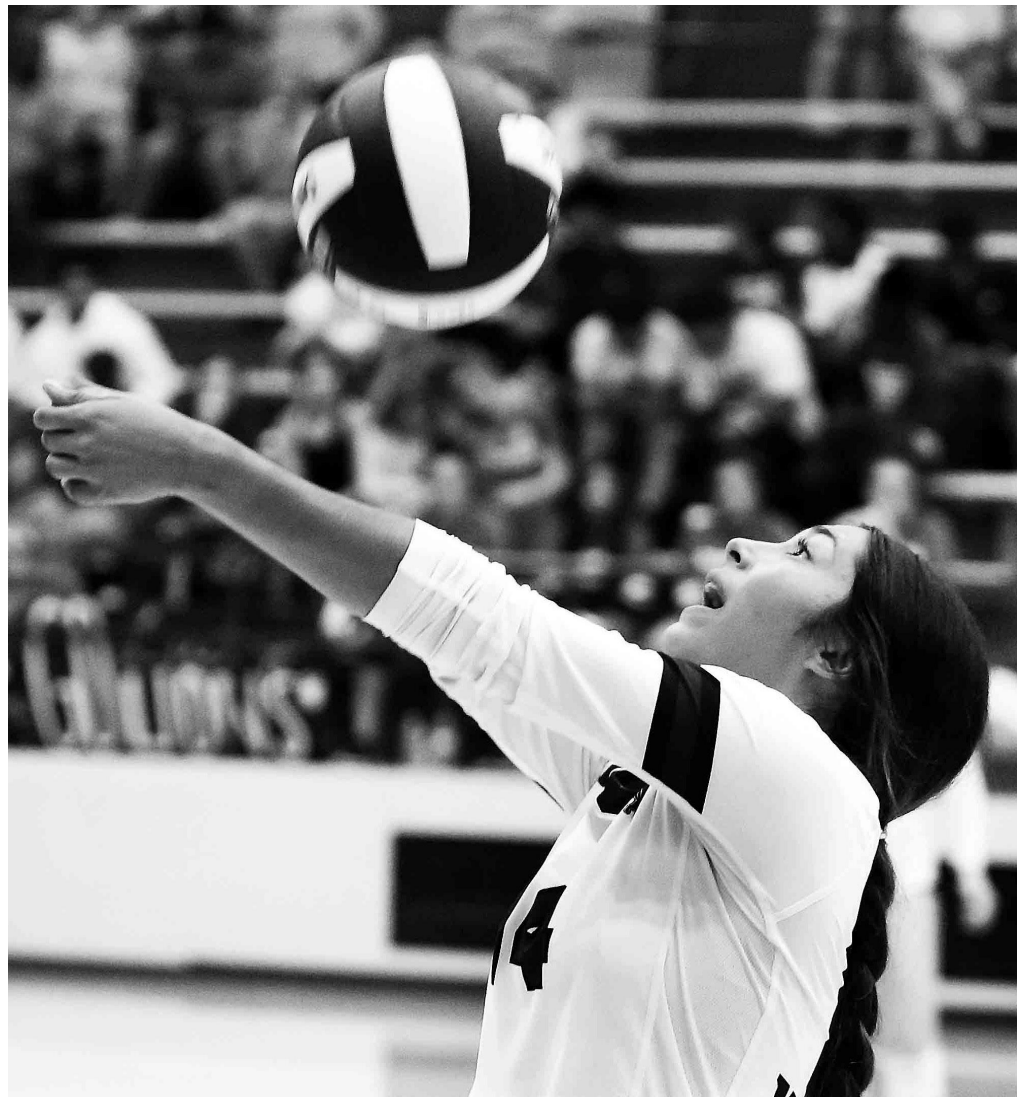
NORTHSIDE TOPS MUNDAY
