Compton and her parents traveled to Lexington's Singletary Center for the Arts on University of Kentucky's campus on Dec. 12 for the state level DYW.

Each participant was given one hour to successfully record talent, self-expression, and fitness.

COVID19 restrictions limited a total of 25 people in the building at once. Participants were solely responsible for hair, makeup, outfit changes, and any last minute touch-ups.

The soft-spoken senior says she was flustered with her own delivery

of the self-expression portion and questioned if her moment pause proved to be too long.

Compton's attention shifted to the Be Your Best Self Award one-page essay requirement on one of the five elements: Be Healthy, Be Studious, Be Ambitious, Be Involved, Be Responsible. She chose "Be Involved."

Compton's quest for a state title continues Saturday, Jan. 9, as the final segment of competition will be a completed— a 10-minute interview with a panel of judges via Zoom.

Compton is confi-

"It is ultimately a conversation, not an interview," said Compton. "They just want to know participant as a person. The interviewers don't want to put pressure on us."

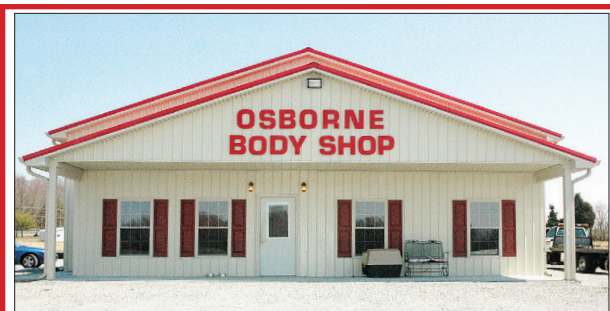

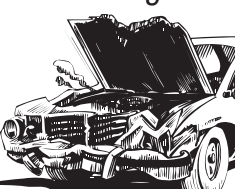
