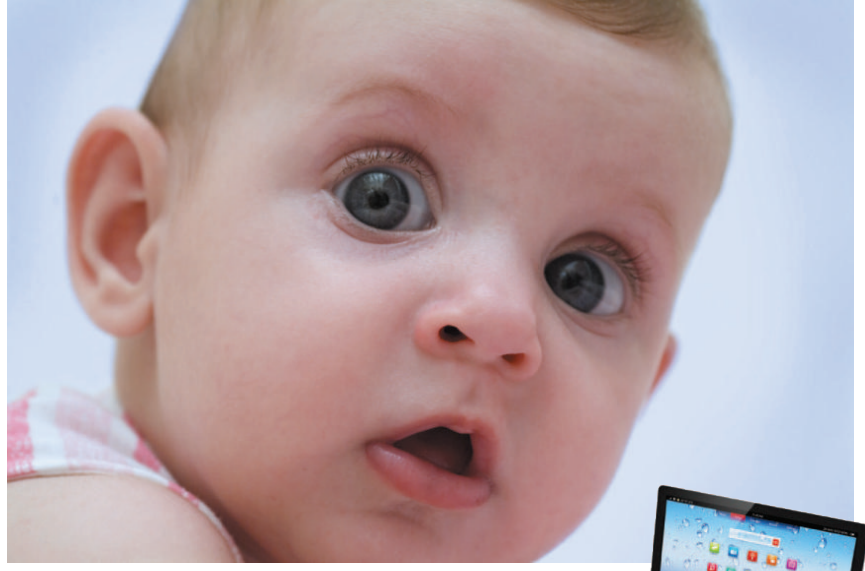
I worked out a lot, despite the pandemic. I successfully made it to 296 consecutive days of workouts... and then I dropped the ball.
