Members of the 4th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry participated in the 159th anniversary event of the Battle of Mill Springs at Zollicoffer Park near Nancy on Jan. 18. Mr. Bill Neirkirk of Somerset, past president of the Mill Springs Battlefield Association, was the key-note speaker. The Mill Springs Battlefield Association was formed in 1992 to help preserve the Battlefield. The battle was fought on Jan. 19, 1862 and was the first Union victory in the Western Theatre. Confederate General Felix Zollicoffer was killed in battle. The 4th Kentucky was established in 1972 at Mill Springs, making it the oldest continuous active Civil War reenacting company in the United States. This year was the first anniversary event at the battlefield since it became part of the Nation Park Service in November 2020.

Lincoln Jamboree delays reopening; now set to reopen Fridays, Sundays

Original plans to reopen Joel Ray's Lincoln Jamboree on Valentine's Day weekend in February have been pushed back until April 3 due to continuing concern over the number of active COVID-19 cases. With that delay, manager Jay Henderson decided to reopen the restaurant beginning this Friday until the Jamboree returns in April.

The restaurant will be open all day on Fridays until April, servicing breakfast from 7:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., lunch from 11 a.m. until 1:30 p.m. and supper from 4 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. All meals will be served curbside. No indoor dining will be

allowed at this time.

In addition, the restaurant will be open on Sunday's with lunch service curbside from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

For orders of 10 or more, Henderson asked for patrons to call ahead 15 minutes in advance at 270-358-3545. All meals are served curbside, where patrons can simply pull to the box office window, pay with any major credit or debit card, then pull around the building and your meal will be delivered to your vehicle curbside.

Longtime friend and companion of the late Joel Ray Sprowls, Mary Lois Morris and manager Jay Henderson wish to thank everyone for their cooperation and support during this time. Henderson commented, "The jamboree will reopen in April as we keep Joel Ray's legacy alive. Until then come visit us curbside every Friday and Sunday at the restaurant."

Have been financially impacted by COVID-19;

Are struggling to pay water, sewer, electric, gas or other heating and cooling bills; and

Have received notice for disconnect between January 21, 2020, and present day and/or up to two months following.

Once a household's application is approved, the local

nonprofit community service provider will transfer funds directly to a utility provider on their behalf.
