

# 1,845 items for food pantry



The Greensburg Rotary Club drive to collect personal care items resulted in the delivery of 1,845 items such as soap, toothpaste toothbrushes, deodorant, detergent and other such items to the Food Pantry Monday. Rotary partnered with the Green County Primary School for the donation of personal care items and offered a pizza party to the class which collected the most items. Rotarians and GCPS personnel are shown with students in Cheyenne Matney's first grade class which won the pizza party by collecting 244 items. Rotarians picked up 1,418 items at the school Monday. First grade collected 530, second grade 412, kindergarten 294 and preschool 164. Items donated by Rotarians and those deposited in boxes at Longhunters Coffee and Tea Co., City Hall, the office of Nancy Stearman, CPA, Community Trust Bank, Limestone Bank and Forcht Bank for three weeks totaled 427.

# GCPS SBDM nominations

An election for two parent representatives to serve on the Green County Primary School Based Decision Making Council is scheduled for Tuesday, May 11, 2021.

The election will be conducted by the GCPS PTO. Votes will be counted and results will be announced during the PTO meeting held at 4 p.m. CT. that day in the school's teacher lunchroom.

The election will be held from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the school.

Only those parents who will have a student enrolled at the school for the 2021 - 2022 school year are eligible to vote or be nominated as a candidate for the SBDM Council.

Nomination forms will be sent to eligible parents Thursday, May 6, 2021. Additional forms are available at the Green County Primary School's office. Current parent members are Jessica Bradshaw, Blake Henry, and Clint Walker. All are eligible for reelection.

Parents may not serve as members of the school council if they or their relatives work in the school in which the parent will serve or in the district central office. They may serve if they work at 270-932-6619 during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. CT

Qualifying parents wanting to be included on the ballot must notify the school in writing before the end of the school day Thursday, May 6, 2021. New council members will receive at least six hours of training to prepare them for their role on the council. Parent members are also required to submit to State and Federal criminal record checks. Green County Primary School is located at 100 Kidz Korner.

Voters must be present to vote.

Election of parent members to the council shall be by majority of the voting qualified parents. These two parents will serve a one-year term beginning July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.

## INSPECTION PERIOD FOR THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT ROLL

The Green County real property tax roll will be opened for inspection from May 3 through May 17, 2021. Under the supervision of the property valuation administrator or one of the deputies, any person may inspect the tax roll.

This is the January 1, 2021, assessment on which state, county, and school taxes for 2021 will be due about October 1, 2021.

The tax roll is in the office of the Property Valuation Administrator at 103 South 1st Street and may be inspected between the hours 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM during week days, and 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM on Saturday, May 8th and 15th.

Any taxpayer desiring to appeal an assessment on real property made by the PVA must first request a conference with the PVA or a designated deputy. The conference may be held prior to or during the inspection period. Due to COVID-19 crises, conferences may be held via video-conference, email, telephone, or fax. Documentation supporting your opinion of value will continue to be required.

After the conference with the PVA or designated deputy, any taxpayer still aggrieved by an assessment on real property may appeal to the county board of assessment appeals.

The taxpayer can appeal his assessment by filing in person or sending a letter or other written petition stating the reasons for appeal, identifying the property and stating the taxpayer's opinion of the fair cash value of the property.

The appeal must be received in the county clerk's office no later than one work day following the conclusion of the inspection period.

A taxpayer failing to appeal to the county board of assessment appeals, or failing to appear before the board, either in person or by designated representative, will not be eligible to appeal directly to the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals.

Appeals of personal property assessments shall not be made to the county board of assessment appeals. Personal property taxpayers shall be served notice under the provisions of KRS 132.450(4) and shall have the protest and appeal rights granted under the provisions of KRS 131.110.

The following steps should be taken when a taxpayer does not agree with the assessed value of personal property as determined by the property valuation administrator.

- (1) He/She must list under protest (for certification) what they believe to be the fair cash value of their property.
- (2) He/She must file a written protest directly with the Department of Revenue, Office of Property Valuation within 30 days from the date of the notice of assessment.
- (3) This protest must be in accordance with KRS 131.110
- (4) The final decision of the Department of Revenue may be appealed to the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals.
