The addition to the rear of the house, which contains a foyer and a chapel, was completed in 2020. The chapel can comfortably accommodate 190 guests and over 250 with the use of an additional room. The funeral home is veteran owned and operated by Jack Gupton, COL (Ret.) William "Bill" and Justine Landrum and Jamie Cole. The Creel House is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
