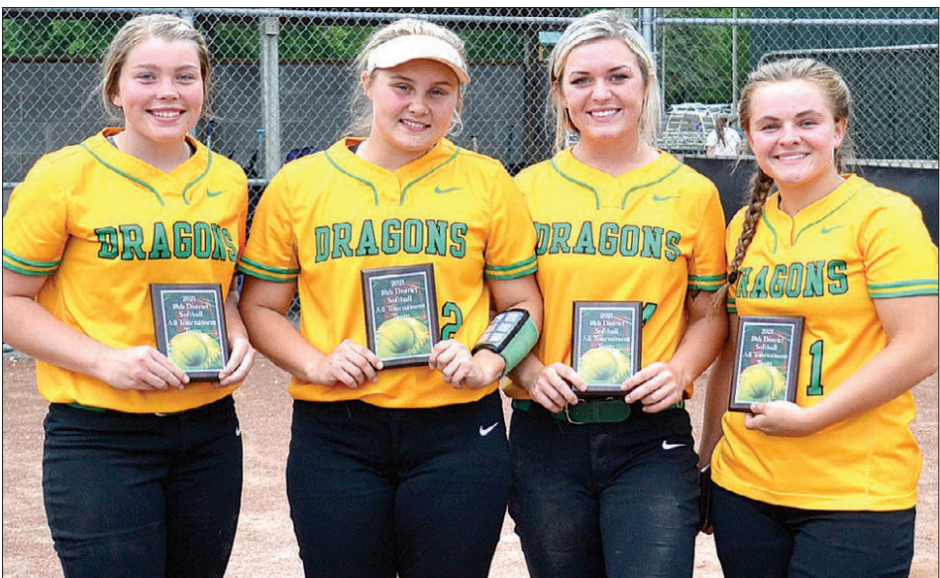
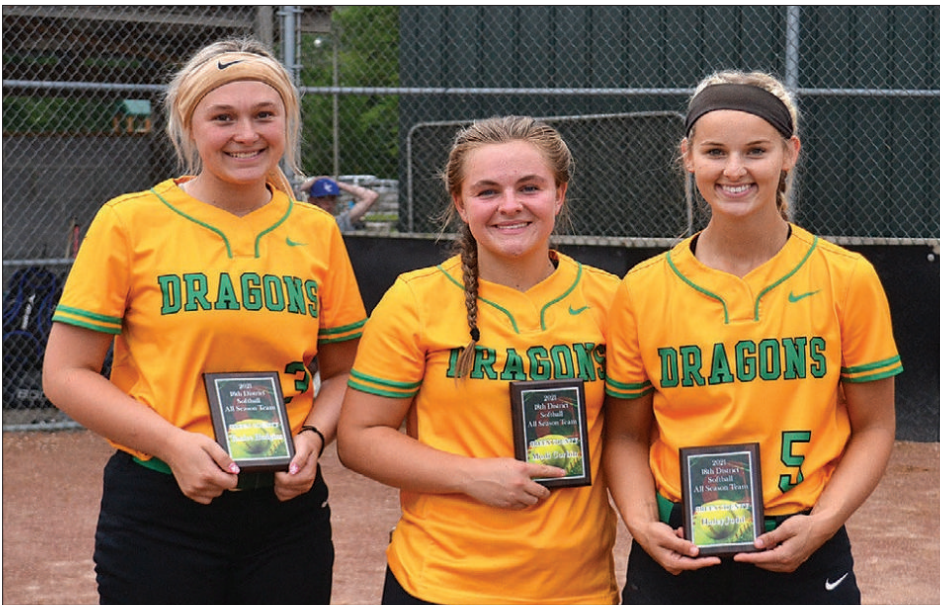

Accolades Baseball and softball athletes recognized

As the regular season winds down in Kentucky for baseball and softball, honors are rolling in for Green County athletes as well as coaches.

Head Baseball Coach Rick Davis was named 5th Region Coach of the Year. Davis is retiring after this year is completed. More information about him is available in another article.

One of his assistants, Mike Daniels, who also serves as GCHS Athletic Director, was a runner-up for Assistant Coach of the Year.

Gunner Bush, who has signed to play baseball with Lindsey Wilson College, was a runner-up in the 5th Region Player of the Year. At the end of the regular season, Bush's batting average was .507, second highest in the 5th Region and tied for 16th in the state. He is tied for fourth in the state with his slugging percentage of 1.014, the best in the region. He is tied for 14th in the state for walks. After several homers early in the season, team often chose to pitch around him in many games.

Blayde Milby, a junior at Green County High School, has been chosen to play in the East-West All Star game later this Summer. During the season he tied for third in the state with 17 doubles.

Caden Scantland has also been chosen to play in the East-West All Star game. He will be playing on the sophomore team. His 0.58 ERA lands him at number four in the state.

Isaac Young picked up 28 walks for the Dragons. This ties him at number 19 in the state.

Casen Murray's 0.71 ERA shows up at number eleven in state leaders. He is also tied at the number five spots with his three saves this year.

Jackson Johnson, another GCHS pitcher,

is tied with Murray and others with three saves.

Jacob Keith and Isaac Young, both juniors at Green County High School, have just this week been added to the roster of the East-West All Star baseball gamethatwillbeplayed later this Summer.

Softball players have also been racking up awards.

Tanlee Hudgins was named Co-Player of the Year in the 5th Region. She tied with Kaitlyn Cissell of Bethlehem.

At the end of the regular season, Hudgins led the state with 19 home runs. Her batting average is .593, the best in the 5th Region and 17th in the state. She is also tied for first in the state with 73 hits. Her slugging percentage is 1.211, which is the best in the 5th Region. Hudgins also has 59 RBIs, which ties her for fifth in the state and is tops in the region. She's also third in the state with 62 runs scored.

Haley Judd was also named to the 2021 All Season Team for the 5th Region. She is tied for 11th in the state with 13 homers. She is ninth in the state in the number of hits with 62. Twenty-one of those hits have been doubles, which places her third in the state. She has 52 RBIs, coming in at the number 16 spot in the state.

Other players were ranked in the top 25 in various categories at the end of the season.

Madi Corbin played long ball eleven times this year, putting her at number 17 in the state. She also had 60 hits, which was good enough for number 13 in the state. Corbin scored 58 times, coming in at number nine in the state.

Katlyn Milby is tied at the number 23 spot for base on balls with 22.

On the pitching side, Tatum Caulk has a record of 18-6, tying her at number 16 for the number of wins.

As a team, the Lady Dragons have more hits and more runs than any other team in the state.
