## Registration For February Citizens Academy

The Marion County Sheriffs Office Citizens Academy and Partnership (CAP) program, a free 13-week educational course about the operations of the Sheriffs Office, is currently accepting applications for classes beginning in February 2021. Classes will be held every Tuesday from 1:00pm- 3:30pm beginning Tuesday, February 2, 2021.

During the program, MCSO staff will highlight all units within the Sheriffs Office, giving citizens an in-depth understanding of what the agency is doing for the community. Each week will focus on a different aspect of the agency, personnel, equipment, policies, procedures and overall function. Students will have an opportunity to view specialty unit equipment, hear from experts in the field of law enforcement, investigations, detention and administration.
