## Dementia Photo Exhibit

The exhibit contains more than 45 framed portraits of famous Americans who are living with or have succumbed to Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. Its purpose is to promote a public discussion about how we must respond to fatal brain disorders that are expected to more than double in our population by 2050.

Today, there are an estimated 30,000 individuals in Lake, Sumter, and Marion Counties living with dementia; a number that is expected to grow to as high as 80,000 over the next 30 years.
