

1 cup green salsa ½ tsp. ground cumin 1 (15 oz.) can Great Northern beans, rinsed and drained 1 (15 oz.) can petite diced tomatoes, drained

2/3 cup chopped cilantro 2 (9 oz.) pkg. refrigerated chicken ravioli 2 cups (8 oz.) shredded Mexican blend cheese

Mix soup, salsa and cumin. Mix beans, tomatoes and cilantro. Layer one-third soup mixture in bottom of a lightly greased 9-inch square baking dish. Arrange onethird of the ravioli over and top with one-third of the bean mixture. Pour layer of cheese. Repeat layers 2 more times, ending with cheese. Bake, covered with foil, for 30 minutes at 400 degrees. Uncover and bake for 15 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

#### BASIL CHICKEN **LASAGNA**

2 cans Cream of Mushroom Soup 1 (16 oz.) carton cottage cheese 1 (12 oz.) jar roasted red peppers, drained and cut into strips 4 cups chopped, cooked chicken

1 cup refrigerated grated

Parmesan cheese

½ cup chopped fresh basil 1 tsp. ground black pepper 9 no-boil lasagna noodles 4 cups (16 oz.) shredded Italian 5-blend cheese, divided

Mix soup and next 6 ingredients together in a large bowl. Layer 3 lasagna noodles on bottom of a lightly greased 13 x 9 inch baking dish. Spoon and spread onethird of the soup mixture on noodles. Sprinkle with 1 1/3 cups cheese. Repeat layers 3 times. Bake, covered at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Uncover and bake for 15 minutes. Let stand 10
