JACKSON, Miss. - As Mississippians moved their clocks forward last Sunday, State Fire Marshal Mike Chaney reminds everyone to test their smoke alarms.

"There were 69 fire deaths in 2020," Chaney said. "In 41 of those fires, there were no working smoke alarms in the home. If you cannot afford smoke alarms, call your local fire department. They may be able to install alarms for free."

The Mississippi State Fire Marshal's Office recommends the following safety

· Test smoke alarms at least once a month using the test

· Replace all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old.
