The most frustrating thing is, by the time the dried seeds start giving

us grief, the overwinter annuals are already beginning to die. Spraying them just makes the plants brown, earlier than normal, but we're still, er, stuck with the stickers. And truth is, spraying them with herbicides this time of the year not only won't work well on plants that are already dying, but weed killers that are normally tolerated by lawns, can weaken or damage your lawn if applied during the


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
