All three suspects charged with capital murder in Holmes Co. ATV investigation

A third suspect, Parveion Harris, 17, in the murder of Kyle Craig, has been arrested and charged with capital murder.

A second suspect, Montavious Landfair, 20, who had been on the run, was arrested by U.S. Marshalls on Friday, June 11. He was apprehended in Durant and taken into custody.

Darius Erving, 17, was arrested on Monday, June 7 in connection with Craig's death.

On June 12, Darius Erving complained of breathing problems. He was taken to the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Lexington at about 10:00 a.m. While being treated at the hospital, Erving escaped.

Sheriff March stated that 24 hours later, the Erving family brought him back to the county jail where he is currently in police custody.

All three suspects are charged with capital murder. Erving is charged with an additional count for escaping from the hospital on Saturday morning.

STARKVILLE, Miss. (AP) — Logan Tanner hit a three-run homer to cap a six-run second inning and Mississippi State advanced to its third straight College World Series with an 11-7 victory over Notre Dame on Monday night in the Starkville Super Regional.

Mississippi State (45-16) advances to play Texas (47-15) on Sunday — seeking its first title in 12 trips to the CWS.

Mississippi State center-fielder Rowdey Jordan denied Brooks Coetzee with a diving catch to end the top of the second, and then the Bulldogs broke it open. Mississippi State loaded the bases twice in the inning, scoring runs on a fielder's choice, sacrifice fly, Kamren James' RBI single, and

Pedestrian killed on Highway 51

According to the Mississippi/National Highway Safety Administration, on Wednesday, June 2 at 10:11 p.m., a vehicle driven by Arthur B. Anderson, age 20, of Goodman, Mississippi struck a pedestrian who was standing on Highway 51, facing east.

The pedestrian named Darlin Flowers, age 39, of Waterloo, Iowa was standing in

the middle of the road when Arthur B. Anderson, northbound, swerved to the left to avoid hitting him; however the front right part of the car hit him, killing him instantly. No other information is available about the deceased or why he was standing in the middle of the road. However, he has a relative from the Vaiden area.

Tchula man killed in accident on Highway 51

According to the Mississippi/National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, on Friday, June 4, at about 11:00 a.m., a freightliner driven by Corey D. Epps of Tchula was traveling north on Highway 51 near the city of West, when the vehicle he was driving left the roadway, veered right, and rolled downhill, off the northbound side of US 51.

The trailer detached from the cab of the vehicle. The cab came to a rest on the east side of Highway 51 on its roof after it rolled over. The trailer came to rest on its right side, facing northeast.

According to authorities, the driver was killed instantly. The cause of the accident or other information about the driver is unknown at this time.
