## McKinley, Le Bonte Club scholarship recipient, makes future plans

Also a basketball player, McKinley finished her senior season as State Farm Athlete of the Month for May, was a Lindy Callahan Scholarship nominee, an All-District Award Player, and the fast pitch softball team's Overall MVP of 2021, leading the team in batting average, home runs, stolen bases, on-base percentage and RBIs.
