Packers, Rams meet for 96th time in Saturday's playoff matchup

When Green Bay hosts Los Angeles in the divisional round at Lambeau Field on Saturday (3:35, FOX), it will be the latest installment in one of the Packers' longest-standing, yet lesser-known, rivalries.

is separated by only thirteen points over the 93 meetings.

The game will be the 96th all-time meeting between the two franchises, including two prior postseason contests. Green Bay rolled over the Rams 28-7 in the Western Conference championship on Dec. 23, 1967, the franchise's only postseason game played at County Stadium in Milwaukee.

From 1950-63, the Packers played at the Rams late in the year, part of a traditional two-game, season-ending swing through California that also included the 49ers. Green Bay lost each time from 1950-58 before breaking through when Vince Lombardi took over, winning every year from 1959-63.

opener, the first regular-season game for the Rams in St. Louis.

As the Rams lagged in the Gateway City, Green Bay won five straight in the series from 2007-15, and were 8-4 overall against the Rams when they called St. Louis home. The last meeting between the

franchises was a 29-27 Green Bay loss in Los Angeles on Oct. 28, 2018.

Current Green Bay head coach Matt LaFleur is a former Rams assistant, as he was the offensive coordinator in Los Angeles for the 2017 season.

In the Rams' former home of St. Louis, many spurned fans have switched their allegiance to the Packers. KTVI-TV, a Fox affiliate in St. Louis, has carried the Green Bay preseason package since 2018, and many regular-season Packer games are on that station.

Eight days later, the Packers claimed their third consecutive NFL title in the famed "Ice Bowl" in wind chills of minus-46 at Lambeau.

The teams also met in the season finales of both 1964 (a 24-24 tie) and 1966 (a 27-23 Green Bay win). Interestingly, the conclusions of the Packers' 1966 and 1967 seasons had some unusual rematches and return visits.

On Jan. 20, 2002, Green Bay suffered its worst playoff defeat in franchise history in a 45-17 road loss to the Rams, who then played in St. Louis, in the divisional round. Brett Favre matched an NFL postseason record with six interceptions, part of eight Green Bay turnovers on the afternoon.

After winning at the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum in the last game of 1966, Green Bay was back at that venue four weeks later for the first-ever Super Bowl, on Jan. 15, 1967.

Unlike the Packers, who have remained in town since their inception in 1919, the Rams are a sort of vagabond franchise, always going where the money is. Founded in 1937, the Rams started out in Cleveland, moved to Los Angeles in 1946, and again to St. Louis in 1995. The franchise then returned to Los Angeles after the 2015 season.

In 1967, the Packers fell to the Rams 27-24 in Los Angeles, then met them again two weeks later in the Western Conference title game in Milwaukee.

As two of the older franchises in the league, Green Bay has played the Rams more than any non-divisional opponent. Los Angeles holds a slim 46-45-2 lead in the regular-season series, which

The Rams' glory days in Los Angeles spanned from the mid-1960s through the 1970s, and they dominated the series with the Packers, with ten wins in eleven meetings from 1968-81. The series was evenly matched until the early 1990s, when Green Bay took over with five wins in six games from 1992-97.

The lone Green Bay loss in that period was a 17-14 setback at Lambeau in the 1995 season
