Six Tiders receive all-conference volleyball honors

Six members of the Crimson Tide varsity volleyball team received all-conference recognition this week.

Coaches cast their votes Wednesday for all-Rock Valley honorees but Edgerton players put up statistics that didn't leave them much choice.

Senior Carly Rebman was

selected to the Rock Valley first team for the second consecutive year. She led the RVC in kills with 4.4 kills per set, was third in total kills with 110 and eighth in digs with 85 total.

"Night in and night out, there's a consistency that you can expect from Carly," head coach Sharon Fox said of her lone senior.

Joining Rebman on the first team for the first time

was junior Kate Gunderson. Gunderson set the gold standard for setters in the conference.

The junior led the league in assists-per-set with 9.2, total aces with 28, and a setting percentage of .350—which Fox referred to as "stellar." Additionally, Gunderson was 9th in the league with 76 digs and 10th with a hitting percentage of .229.

Junior Abby Blum was

similarly superlative at libero for the Tide, earning a spot on the second team. Blum led the league in digs with 128 and digs-per-set with 5.1.

"It's an impressive feat for anyone—let alone someone who is new to the position," wrote Fox.

Sophomore Shannon Rusch moved up to second-team recognition after receiving an honorable mention last season as a freshman. Rusch

was 5th in the league in kills-per-set with 3.2 and 6th in total kills with 81.

"Shannon's growth in all areas was huge and paved the way for our success," Fox previously told the Edgerton Reporter. "Shannon provided a constant weapon at the outside hitter position.

Juniors Carmen Crandall and Hannah Zeimet both earned honorable mentions for their performances this

season.

"We feel like we're in a good place with both Hannah and Carmen playing the middle," Fox said. "By the end of the season, we were really seeing some results, and that's exciting as we look to the future in bringing them back."

Crandall was 8th in the RVC in hitting percentage with .253 and Zeimet was 11th in blocks with 8.

Dane County Training Center Shooting Range opens to public

The shooting ranges at the Dane County Law Enforcement Training Center will once again be open to the public on weekends beginning Saturday, May 15th.

As in past years, the Sheriff's Office is partnering with the Wisconsin DNR to

provide a safe and convenient facility for target shooting. Public hours will be on Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The training center is located at 5184 Highway 19 in the town of Westport and is equipped with long gun and handgun firearm ranges.

Fees are \$10 per person per day and must be paid with cash or personal check.

Credit cards are not accepted. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. A minor must be at least 12 years old and present proof of enrollment or completion of the DNR Hunter Safety Program to shoot at the range.

Staff and customers will be adhering to COVID-19 protocols, including:

- All individuals entering the Dane County Law

Enforcement Training Center must wear a mask, no exceptions or entry will be denied.

- Individuals may opt to wear a mask while outdoors or on the range.
- When entering the facility, individuals will be required to stay at least six (6) feet away from the next person in line unless they are a family member. Measurements will be masked on the floor.

- Shooting lanes on the range will be restricted to the use of every other lane, providing a ten (10) foot distance between each shooter.
- Disinfectant/hand sanitizer will be available upon entry to the building and on the range.
- Extra cleaning/disinfecting will be done on multiple use items.

- Length of time to spend at the range will be at the discretion of staff, based on the number of individuals waiting their turn.

The two-week Hunter Sight-In program is scheduled for November 6 – 19, 2021, and will allow for public hours during the week, as well as expert assistance to sight-in firearms for the deer hunting season.

Wisconsin Guard soldiers begin grueling Best Warrior competition

Before the sun crested the horizon this morning, 22 Wisconsin Army National Guard Soldiers began a grueling three-day gauntlet known as the Best Warrior Competition.

The demanding competition pits soldiers from across the state against each other as well as the limits of their own endurance, taking the measure not only of their physical fitness but their skills in land navigation, soldier tasks, military bearing and composure.

"No specific military

occupational specialty has an advantage, and each and every competitor will be pushed to their physical and mental limits through the vast array of tasks that will be completed over the 64 hours of competition," said Command Sgt. Maj. Curtis Patrouille, the Wisconsin Army National Guard's senior enlisted leader.

These Soldiers from the Wisconsin Army National Guard's 32nd Infantry Brigade Combat Team, 64th Troop Command, 157th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade, 426th Regional Training Institute and the Wisconsin Army National Guard's Recruiting and Retention Battalion are vying

for the honor of being named the Wisconsin Army National Guard's Best Warrior and Noncommissioned Officer of the Year. The two soldiers who win those titles will represent Wisconsin at next month's regional Best Warrior Competition, where they will match up against their peers from six neighboring states in hopes of advancing to the national competition.

The state level Best Warrior Competition resumes this year following a one year hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

"I am so proud of the efforts of the Wisconsin National Guard Soldiers and Airmen with all of their efforts over

the past 12 months to help turn the tide with the COVID pandemic, and with risk mitigations in place, I'm very excited to be able to hold this esteemed competition once again," Patrouille said.

Competition to advance from the brigade level is just as competitive as the state level competition, Patrouille said. Advancing to the state level competition is an honor in itself.

"With the operations tempo that the Wisconsin National Guard has had during the past 12 months with the COVID response, civil unrest, wildfire support, as well as election support, I stand in awe at the level of commitment these competitors have put in, not only for the preparation for the Best Warrior Competition, but for their steadfast dedication to the citizens of the state of Wisconsin and the nation,"

Patrouille said.

The Best Warrior Competition at Fort McCoy is not open to the public, but photos and live updates throughout the event will be posted on the Wisconsin National Guard's Facebook page. Stay tuned throughout the weekend.
