Tider runners score personal bests at CamRock Invitational

A course made fast by dry weather enabled all six members of the Crimson Tide's cross country team to turn in personal best times

during a meet at CamRock Park on Sept. 2.
“They were all able to shave off 30 seconds from their best times,” coach Alle Knop told The Reporter on Sept. 8

—Josh Pelzel: 23:30:08
—Aidan Greenly: 33:07:01.
Knop said Pelzel's time was noteworthy.

“It's the first 5K he's ever run, so him coming with a 23-minute time is really impressive, especially with only a week of practice.”


Clarence


