of Veterans and homes' staff, expanded use of COVID-19 data analytics and launching an Essential Caregiver Program that enables Veterans to have direct contact in the homes with a designated family member to help ensure the Veteran's health and wellbeing while COVID-19 restrictions are in place.

Personally identifiable and other closed information has been redacted from the investigation report in compliance with confidentiality requirements. A 50-page summary of the report had been released to the public on December 2, 2020.

The Missouri Veterans Commission, a division of the Department of Public Safety, operates seven State Veterans Homes, five State Veterans Cemeteries, and the Veterans Services Program. The Commission is committed to honoring and serving Missouri's Veterans whose dedication and sacrifices have preserved our nation and its freedoms. 
