### St. Robert Neon Refurbishment Requirements Scope of Work for Modern Cabins Neon Sign

1. Each sign and cabinet will be rebuilt as necessary, maintaining as much of the original structure and appearance as possible.
2. All original porcelain faces will be preserved, cleaned of any overlying paint or oxidation and polished as much as is reasonably possible. Painted faces will be preserved if they retain sufficient brilliance and stabilized, replaced or repainted where necessary.
3. New cabinetry will be rebuilt as may be necessary, made ready for mounting on site and painted with an enamel weather resistant paint.
4. All neon tubing will be made new and replaced according to original practices utilizing neon electrode housings and avoiding surface connections whenever possible. The neon tubing shall be made from premium components according to the diameter and color of the original.
5. All electrical hardware and neon transformers will be replaced with new UL 2161 compliant fixtures and wired according to current electrical code.
6. The City will deliver the signs. The winning bidder will return signs and re-mount utilizing new steel poles where necessary to afford a minimum 8' (eight) clearance from the ground. Additional height and engineering will be the responsibility of the city of St. Robert. The poles shall be configured in a way to attach to the mountings provided in coordination and consultation with the city of St. Robert with either sleeving or a plate to mount to J bolts.
7. Each sign shall be made ready for primary electrical connection with a weather proof service entrance and disconnect switch on the sign.
