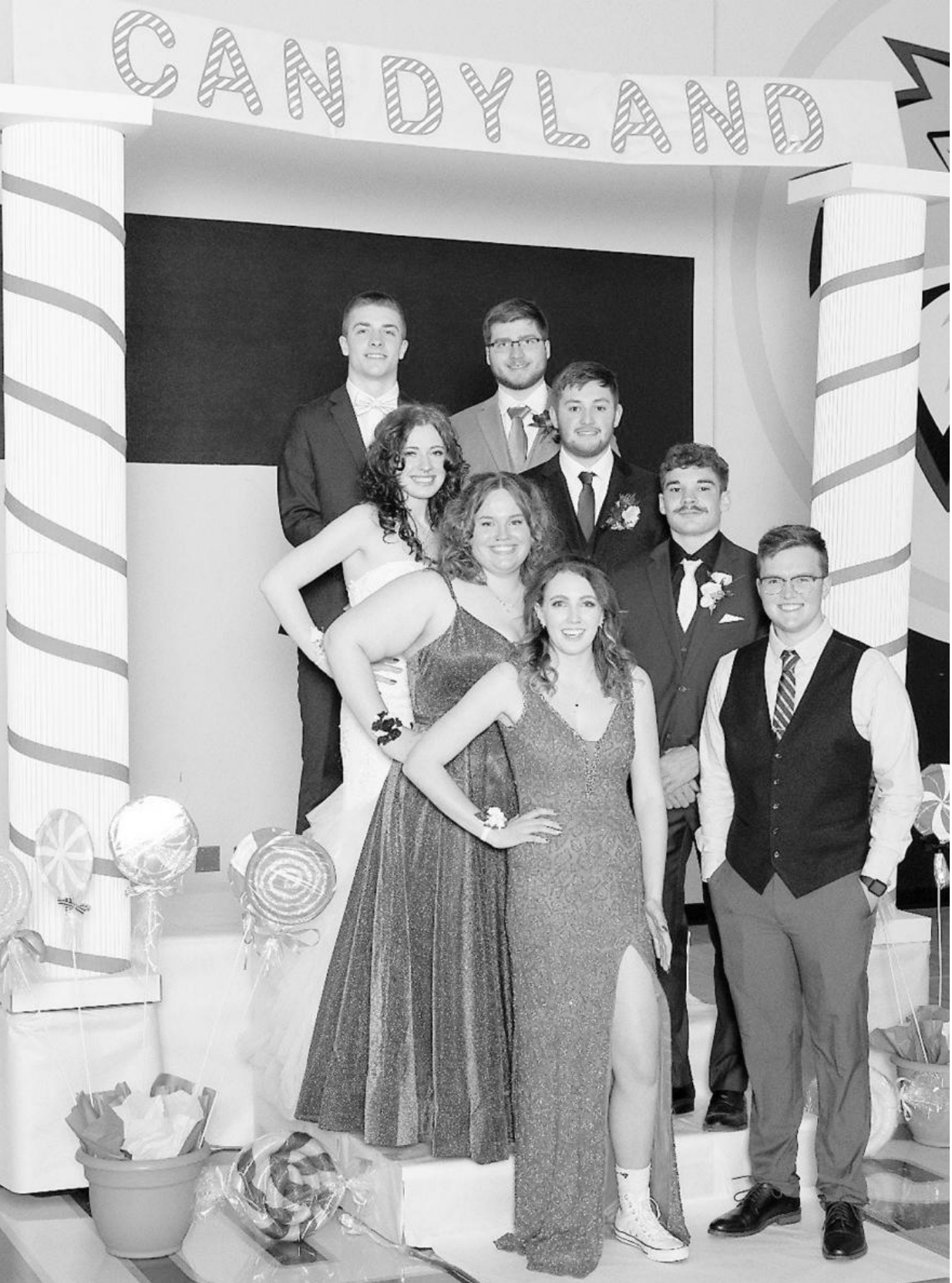
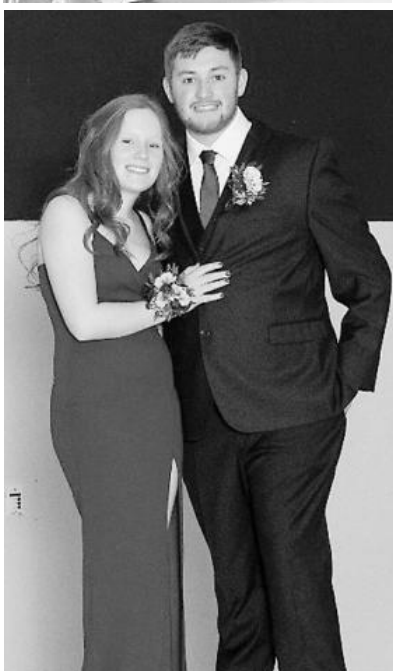
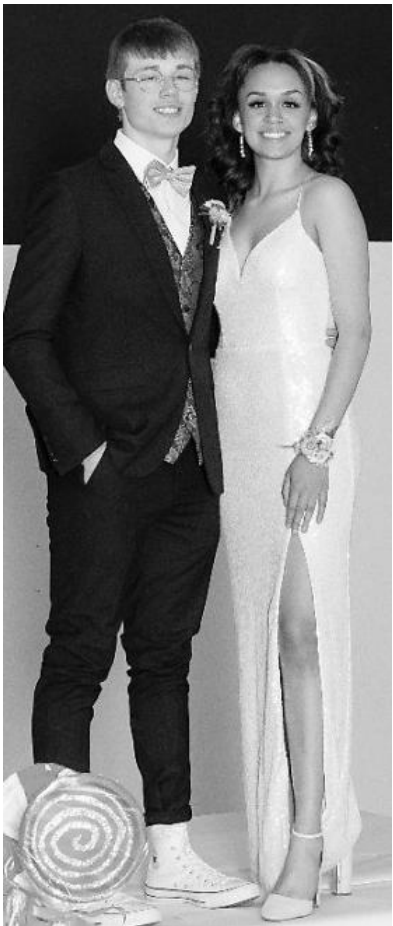
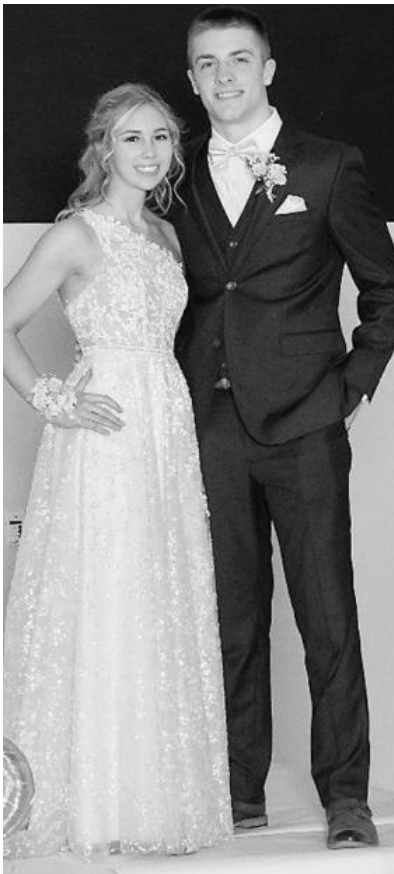
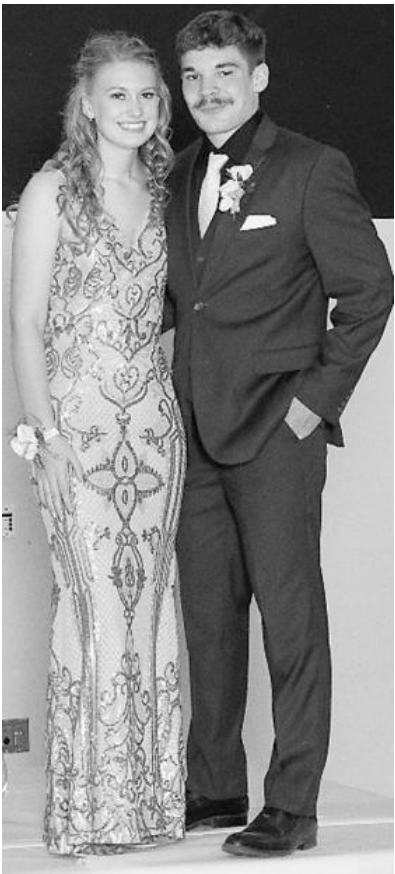


# Students Spend A Night In Candyland
