Rothsay Round-Up Is New Event In Rothsay

Giddy up and get ready for a wild ride at the Rothsay Round Up. After a year off, a city celebration comes back to Rothsay, but rather than the "Prairie Days" of recent past, Rothsay is bringing back the "Round Up" of the '40s and '50s. Rothsay is ready is back and ready to entertain the crowds over the last two days in July, showcasing the great opportunities to feature local businesses, community organizations, and welcome many new visitors to the beautiful prairie community of Rothsay.

Starting on Friday, July 30, Wojo's Rodeo rides into town with a full slate of activities and events for Friday and Saturday night. From saddle brone riding to barrel racing to mutton busting, there is something for everyone. Grandstands open at 4:30 with the rodeo starting at 6:00.

Adults are featured in the multiple roping, wrestling, and riding events, but Wojo's Rodeo also showcases some of the new, young, upcoming talents in junior bull riding, mini bronc riding, goat tying, and mutton busting.



On Saturday, July 31 festivities ride on in to the main street. The City Parade starts at 10:00 beginning at the Fire Hall.

Following the parade, events open at 12:00 at East Park. Kids can have their "hay" day with the Kiddie Pedal Pull. Showcasing their leg strength and tractor driving skills, kids compete to work toward a full pull, causing as much excitement and cheering as any other activity in Rothsay.

Also available for the young and the young-at-heart is the Trowbridge Creek Petting Zoo, running from 12-4. Get up close and personal with a wide variety of animals.

A variety of food vendors and the beer garden are located at East Park and are available at high noon through 4:00 p.m.

After a fully belly, test your luck with a few games and competitions. BINGO runs from 1:00-3:00 p.m. and a horseshoe tournament takes place from 2:00-4:00 p.m.

Then take a few minutes to get spruced up before attending the second night of Wojo's rodeo with the grandstand opening at 4:30 and the rodeo starting at 6:00.

When the last bull is ridden and the final calf roped, stick around for the Honky-Tonk Stardust Cowboys on Saturday night. Performance is at the grounds after the rodeo's conclusion.
