Kate is the daughter of Shay and Jim Shingler, and the granddaughter of Dell Shingler and Jim Stanley of Tallahassee.

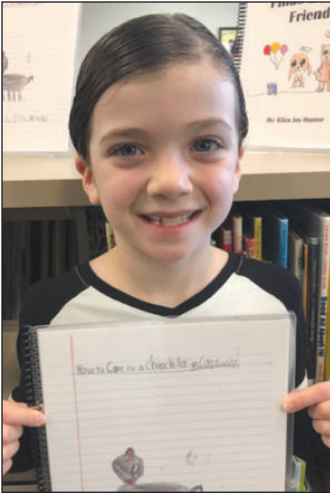


Ellie Alexander wins picture book contest
