Compared to last week's market, all weight class price averages of both feeder steers and heifers ended fully \$2 to \$4 higher. Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls finished mostly steady with last weeks prices, the combinations of shorter show lists, higher box prices along with general enthusiasm and optimism resulted in a strong futures board closing. Even with the cold, wet, weather coming the stocker buyers showed momentum in securing inventory. Buyer trade was brisk with the demand good on most all classes.
We have moved starting time to 11:00 for the rest of the year due to increasing volume.

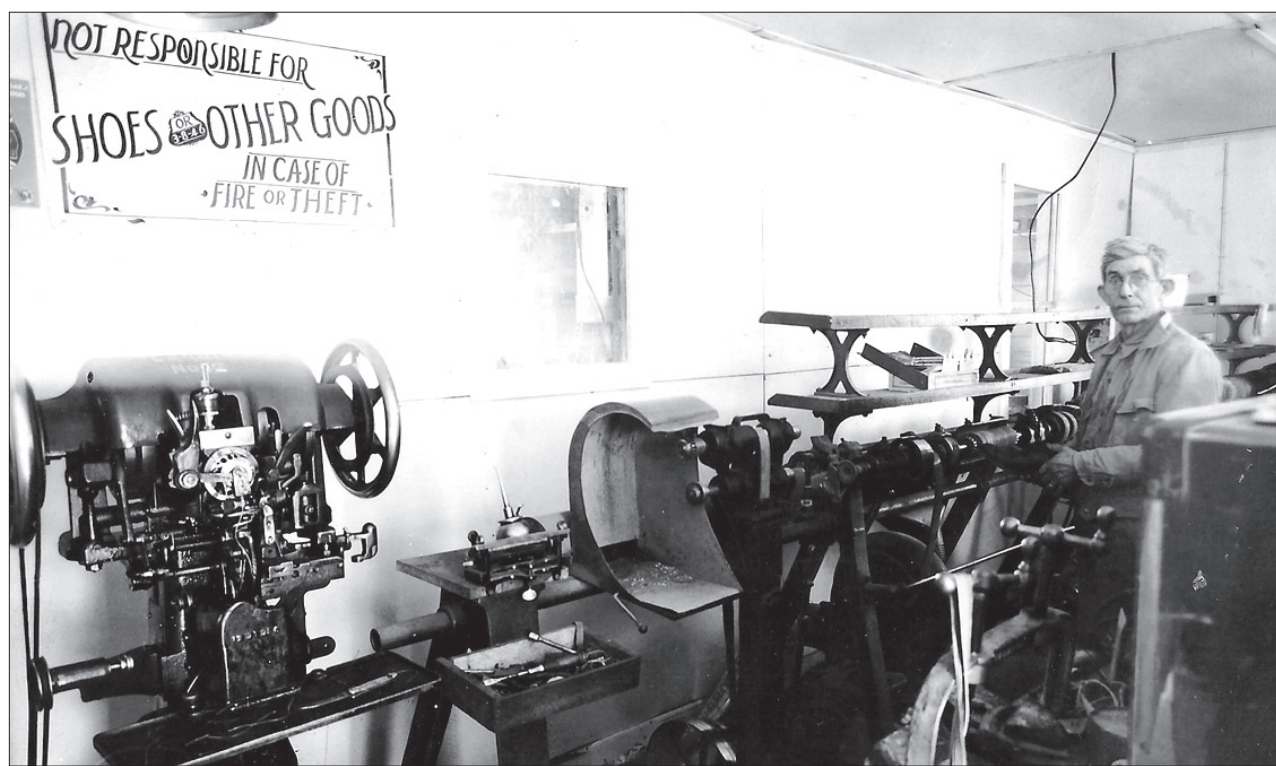
