(continued from page 1) sanitizer, sanitizing wipes, disinfectant spray, earbuds or headphones labeled with name, and pencil pouch (that fits in binder).

Classroom Wish List: dividers with pockets, gallon Ziplock bags - boys, quart or sandwich Ziploc bags - girls, and dry erase markers. For specials: music - one box of tissue; art - Ziplock bags; and computer - one box of tissue.

Third grade
Student Supplies: individual pencil pouch with three rings for binder, three composition notebooks (no spirals), one pack of dividers, two glue sticks, one pair nice quality ear buds (can be Bluetooth or corded), two highlighters, three plastic pocket folders (two pockets, no prongs), two packs pre-sharpened pencils, and one box crayons.

Classroom Wish list: Clorox wipes, Expo markers, paper towels, page protectors, Lysol spray, and box of Kleenex.

For specials: music - one box of tissue; art - washable markers and children's scissors; and com-

puter - one box of tissue.

Fourth grade
Student Supplies: One regular size bookbag (two shoulder straps preferred), six one-subject notebooks (for reading, English, writing, social studies, math, and science), two laminated/plastic pocket folder with prongs, two highlighters (different colors), one set of earbuds/headphones (for classroom use and computer specials), and pack of three dry erase markers (for math). Pencil pouch is optional. Please no binders. For specials: music - one box of tissue; art - Sharpies and liquid glue; and computer - one box of tissue.

Classroom Wish List: The following items will be collected and used throughout the year as needed: three packs wide ruled loose leaf notebook paper, pencils, pack of three glue sticks, three boxes of tissues, one large bottle of hand sanitizer, Clorox/Lysol Brand sanitizing wipes, sandwich or snack size Ziploc bags (girls bring these), gallon size Ziploc bags (boys bring these), and pa-

per towels.

Fifth grade
Student Supplies: individual pencil pouch or pencil box, two-three packs of loose-leaf notebook paper, one 12 count pack of pencils, one pack of cap erasers, one four count pack of glue sticks, one pack of highlighters, one set of earbuds for your child's personal use (please place in a Ziploc bag and label with his/her name), three boxes of tissue, one large bottle of hand sanitizer and one Clorox/Lysol brand sanitizing wipes. For specials: music - one box of tissue; art - Ticonderoga pencils and glue sticks; and computer - one box of tissue.

Classroom Wish list: extra notebook paper, Ziploc bags: gallon, quart, or snack, and Expo chisel tip dry erase markers.

Gifted: Ziplock bags (gallon and quart size), one pack of markers and/or colored pencils (for personal use), one roll paper towels, and one box Kleenex.

Wish list: disinfecting sanitizing wipes.
Middle School

Sixth grade
School Supplies - mandatory items: headphones or earbuds must be corded. For sanitary reasons no wireless earbuds will be allowed.

Homeroom Teacher: Tissue, paper towels, hand sanitizer, zip-lock bags.

Math: one-inch binder with wide-ruled paper, and journal - not a spiral bound composition book.

Language arts: two-inch binder with notebook paper, one composition book with 100 pages, and set of 5 dividers.

Science: spiral notebook with at least 150-200 sheets (vinyl cover will be best). Social studies: one half-inch binder with wide ruled paper.

Social Studies: 1 1/2 binder with wide ruled paper.

All subjects - enough for all year: wide-ruled notebook paper, pencils with erasers, highlighters, colored pencils or markers, and glue - four ounce or larger bottle, stored in a Ziploc bag.

Classroom Wish List: tissue,

paper towels, large or small ump bottles of hand sanitizer, and box of Ziploc bags (quart, sandwich, or gallon size).

Seventh grade

School Supplies: This list covers math, science, social studies, and English language arts, one pair earbuds or headphones (must have wires, no Bluetooth), three, one-inch, three-ring binder notebooks (two if you want to combine science and social studies), one, one-and one-half inch three ring binder for math, loose-leaf notebook paper, red ink pens, blue or black ink pens, highlighters, pencils (if students use a mechanical pencil, be sure extra lead is provided), one covered pencil sharpener, one small pack 3x5 white index cards, one 12 pack colored pencils, one white-out fluid or white-out pen, one box Kleenex (homeroom class), one roll paper towels, boys one small box sandwich size zip-lock bags, girls one small box gallon size zip-lock bags, one bottle hand sanitizer (homeroom class), and

one subject spiral notebooks.

Eighth grade:
School Supplies: Three (1 1/2 inch) three ring binder, one (one inch) three ring binder, two sets of five tab dividers, five packs paper (college or wide ruled), eight highlighters (different colors - yellow, orange, blue, green, pink, etc.), one dry erase marker, graph paper, index cards, scientific calculator - to be able to do students homework (TI-30XS recommended), one box colored pencils or markers, pencils with erasers (for all year), two red, two blue pens (for all year), earbuds or headphones for use with Chromebooks, one mouse to be used with Chromebooks (optional), hand-held pencil sharpener with cover, correction fluid (White Out), one pack of sticky notes, and glue stick.

Optional supplies: one pair of scissors, mini stapler, jumbo eraser, water bottle, one box tissue paper (to be given to first block teacher), hand sanitizer (personal use), and folder for extra papers.
