

Bus routes and drives announced for 2021-22

Sharon Bryan - Bus #08-1 (AM): This route begins on Parks Road. Parks Road, Soap Creek Lodge Road, Ann Scott Lane, Hwy. 378 to Greenbriar Drive, Pineridge Drive; back to Hwy. 378, turn right on Kelly Street, Wallace-Wells, come back to Hwy. 378, turn right; turn left on Humphrey Street, left on Perryman Avenue, right on Florence Street, right on Dallas Street, right on Hwy. 47, right on Morningside Drive, turns around, comes back to Hwy. 47, right on Lillian Sims Drive, turn left on Spring Court, turns around, comes back to Lillian Sims Drive, turns left, left on Ward Avenue, right on South Peachtree Street, right on School Street, left on Dallas Street, left on Humphrey Street, left on Hwy. 378, right on Elam Avenue, left on Martin Street, right on Lincoln Avenue, right on Jiggs Smalley Street, left on Elam Street, go across Metasville Road to Drinkard Street, turn around, come back to Metasville Road, turn right, go to the school. (PM): Reverse route.

Greg Reilly - Bus #18-04 (AM): Begins on Broad River Scenic Drive, turn left on Broad Acres Road, turn left on Hwy. 79, turn right on LBK Road, go around the circle, come back to Hwy. 79, turn right, turn left on Gills Point Road by Beulah Church, go to Lathan Road, turn around, come back out to Hwy. 79, turn left on Hwy. 79, turn left on Graball Road, turn right on Holiday Estates Road, left on Lincoln Street, right on Shore Line Drive, come back to Lincoln Street, turn left, turn right on Holiday Estates Road, left on Graball Road, left on Hwy. 79, turn left on Lake View Drive (before Fishing Creek bridge), go to Third Street, turn right on Third Street, right on First Street, left on Lakeview, right on Hwy. 79, go across Fishing Creek bridge, turn left on Fishing Creek Estates Road, find a place to turn around, back to Hwy. 79, turn left, first part of this route ends at Midway Church Road. Remainder of route starts on Hwy. 79, past Prater Road. Pick up students from Prater Road to LCES. Turn right on Rowland York Drive, left on Metasville Road, come to the school. (PM): Reverse route.

Debra Poland - Bus #14-1 (AM): This route begins on Ashmore-Barden Road. Goes to Bass Road, turns around, turns left on Bonner Road, turns left on Plantation Point Road, goes into Plantation Point and goes around Plantation Point Circle back to Hwy. 47, turn left, left on Overlook Road, right on Price Road (dirt road) turn right on Hwy. 47, turn left on Trulock Road, turn left on Oak Drive, turns around on Pinecone Drive, comes back to Hwy. 47, turn left, picks up Hwy. 47 (Augusta Highway) from Plantation Point to Cliaitt's Crossing. Picks up no more students until bus gets to Gibson Tire Co. where this bus picks up and drops off. End of route. (PM): Reverse route.

Wayne Epps - Bus #16-1 (AM): This route begins on Double Branches Road, turns right on Hwy. 200 at Martin's Crossroads, turn left onto Tankersley Road right on Ashmore-Barden Road, turns left on Bass Road, turns right on Price-Reese Road, turns right on Dixie Lane, turns around, comes back to Price-Reese Road, turns left, comes to Double Branches Road, turns right, turns left on Poland Road, goes into Pleasant View Circle, back around to Poland Road, turn left, come back to Double Branches Road, turn left, turn right on White Oak Road, turns around, picks up Penny Lane, turns around, turn right on Double Branches Road, turn right on Moseley Road, turn around, turn right on Double Branches, responsible for Camp Daniel Marshall, turn around, left on Double Branches, turn right on Indian Cove Road, turn left on Comanche Circle, turn right on Cherokee Drive, turn right on Comanche Circle, turn left on Indian Cove Road, turn left on Double Branches, turn right on Holloway Road, turn around, turn right on Double Branches Road, responsible for all of Double Branches Road, comes to Augusta Hwy., turns left on Elam Heights, right on Thomson Hwy, pick up at Wee Wisdom, come to school. (PM): Reverse route.

Tammie Harley - Bus #16-2 (AM): This route begins on Crook Road, turn left on Loco Church Road, turn left on Hwy. 220 W., turn left on Rachels Road, turns around, comes back to Hwy. 220 W., turns left, turns right on Gold-

man-Johnson Road, turns left on Hwy. 43 (Thomson Hwy.), turns left on Mercier Road, turns right on Hwy. 220 W., turns right on Hwy. 378, comes in the city of Lincolnton, turns left on Lincoln Avenue, turns left on Metasville Road, end of route. (PM): Reverse route

Donna Hutton - Bus #18-04 (AM): This route begins on Clary Road off Hwy. 220 E., (if there are any students), then begin on Indian Road, turn left on Montego Drive, turn right on Jamaica Avenue, turn right on Bermuda Avenue, turn left on Montego Drive, turn left on Indian Road, responsible for Apache Drive, Chickasaw Lane, Pawnee Drive, Seminole Drive, Indian Circle, Miami Drive, turn around, come back out of Indian Road, turn right on Fortson Road (dirt road), turn left on Hwy. 220 E., turn right on Rowland Road, turn around at first house on left, turn left on Hwy. 220 E., turn left on Hwy. 378 (toward Lincolnton), right on Bethany Church Road, right on Talbert Road, turn around at the first house on the Right, go across to Iveytown Road, turn left on Hwy. 79 come into the city of Lincolnton at the traffic light (Golden Pantry), take a right on Hwy. 79, then heads to Anthony St. Exit Anthony St. and take a left onto 378, turn right at the Golden Pantry on Goshen Street, pick up all students, turn left on Hwy. 378. End of route. This route is also responsible for taking students to the 4-H Office in the afternoons (288 N. Peachtree Street) (PM): Reverse Route

Bruce Haislip - Bus #17-1 (AM): This route will begin on White Rock Road, pick up all of White Rock Road, turn left on Hwy. 220 to Water Oak Subdivision. Pick up all of Water Oak Subdivision. Back to Hwy. 220, turn left to Hwy. 47 (Augusta Highway), turn left onto Augusta Highway, turn left on Pineywoods Road (dirt road). Pick up all of Piney Woods Subdivision. Back to Partridgetown Road, turn right and to the Augusta Highway. Turn left and come to the school. (PM) Reverse Route

Shannon Penrow - Bus #06-29 (AM): This bus route will begin on the Thomson Hwy., (May Avenue) across from The Lincoln Center. Picks up students on dirt road across from The Lincoln Center (Kevin Beggs' rental property), turn right onto Lincoln Apartments. Responsible for all pickups at Lincoln Apartments, May Avenue, turns right on Claire Drive, turn right on Thomson Hwy., turns right on Lewis Family Road, turns right on Saddle Brook Sub-Division, turn around, turns right on Lewis Family Road, turns left onto Hwy. 378, right on Bryant Road, turns right onto Hwy. 378, turn right on Lewis Crook Road, turns left on CE Norman Road, turn around at Wellmaker-Crook/ CE Norman Road. Responsible for CE Norman, come back to Lovelace Road, turn left, end of route is end of Lovelace Road, turn right on Metasville Road, come to school. (PM): Reverse route.

Collen Leroy - Bus #13-01 (AM): This route starts on Ralph Goolsby Road, turn left on Hwy. 220 E, go to four way stop at Chamberlain Ferry/Hwy 220, turn left, go up to Reed Road, turn right on Reed Road, turn right on Hwy. 220, pick up all students between Hwy. 220 and Chamberlain Ferry. Go to four way stop, turn left on Chamberlain Ferry Road, go to the end of Chamberlain Ferry Road (at the boat ramp) turn around and works back up Chamberlain Ferry Road, responsible for all pickups which include, but may not be a complete listing: Cedar Road, Pine Grove Church Road, Joy Road, Cardinal Lane, Po Folks Lane, Pardon Drive (Road), Parks Grove Church Road, Sims Road, Baker Davis Road, Pugh-Kahn Road and Albert Road. At the end of Chamberlain Ferry Road, turn right on Hwy. 47, comes into the City of Lincolnton, turn right on Sunrise Drive. Come to the school. (PM): Reverse route.

Carlean Mercier - Bus #18-1 (AM): This bus route will begin on Cartledge Road. Goes to the end of Cartledge Road, turns left on Leathersville Road, turns left on Jones-Martin Road, turns left on Williams Circle, turns right on Jones-Martin, turns left on Leathersville Road, picks up Beard Drive, continue Leathersville Road, this route stops at Leathersville Road and Hwy 43. Comes to the school. (PM): Reverse route.

Michael Wengrow - Bus #07-2 (AM): This route starts on Petersburg Road. Turn left into Petersburg Place, turn left and continue

to pick up on Petersburg Road, turn left onto Hwy. 378, to to the Tastee Freeze and turn right, turn left onto Joan Way and pickup students. Turn left on Hwy. 79, turn right on Hwy 378, Turn right on Hwy. 378. End of route. First Baptist Street, turns in front of First Baptist Street, crosses House Street, goes to Watson Street Extension, comes back to House Street, turns right on Metasville Road, turns right on Rowland-York Road, stops at Wells Street, continues on Rowland-York Road, turns right on Hwy. 79, turns right on Hwy. 378. Continues on to Petersburg Place and Jones Way. End of Route. Bus then comes to the school. (PM) Reverse route

Debra Partridge - Bus #12-02 (AM): This bus route will begin at the traffic light at the intersection of Highway 79/ Elberton Highway (Golden Pantry) and Highway 378/ McCormick Highway and go up Hwy. 79 to Petersburg Road, turn right, begin pickups. Will pick up all students on: New Petersburg Road/turns around at Price's Grove Church come back to New Petersburg Road, turn left, turn left on Firetower turn right on Norman Road, back to Firetower Road, turn right, go to Hwy. 79 turn left, turn left on Lily Way, responsible for Lilly Way, Jackie Way, Cathy Way, Bill Way, turn onto Bill Way, go to Hwy. 378, turn right, turn left on Kings Way, pick up Kings Way. End of Route. (PM): Reverse route.

Sammie Dawkins - Bus #07-3 (AM): This route will begin picking up on Hwy. 220 between Cliaitts Crossing and Martins Crossroads straight across to Maxim Road turn right on Nathania Farm Road, turn around straight across to Guillebeau Road turn right on Wells Creek Drive to the end of Wells Creek Drive and turn around back to Guillebeau Road turn right onto Maxim Road turn right on Annie Kate Elam Drive (off Maxim Road) back to Maxim Road turn right on Double Branches Road right on the Augusta Highway. Picks up from Gibson Tire Co then turns left on Lumber Street, pick up all of Lumber Street. End of route. (PM): Reverse route.

Glenn Bryan - Bus #15-1 (AM): This route begins on Hwy. 220 W. turn left on Mt. Zion Church Road turn left on Forest Lake Drive, does all of Forest Lake Estates comes back to Mt. Zion Church Road turn left on Hidden Harbour Road does all of Hidden Harbour comes back to Salem Church Road turns left on Booths Branch Road turns around back to Salem Church Road, turns left gets on Hwy. 220 W. comes to Thomson Highway (Hwy. 43) turns right on Jones Chapel Road turns around, back to Hwy. 43 turns right on Hwy. 43 comes into the City of Lincolnton turns right on Elam Heights turns left on Hwy. 47 turns right on S. Peachtree turns left on Main Street picks up and delivers students on Main Street/South Peachtree Street (Taxidermy, City Pharmacy, Rick and Co., Grove Street, etc) end of route. (PM): Reverse route

Jack Smalley - #12-2 (AM): This route starts on Metasville Road turn right on Sutton Road, turn around, turn left on Metasville Road, turn left on Prater Road to Aycock-Norman turn around turn left on Hearst-Cebo Road, turn around, responsible for Seed Tick Road turn left on Metasville Road, picks up all of Metasville Road to the school. (PM): Leave LCHS turns left on Metasville Road, turn right on Rowland York, turn back into LCES parking lot, delivers teachers' children. Comes back out to Metasville Road, turns right, turns right on Hearst-Cebo Road, turns around comes back out, turns right on Metasville Road, turns right on Sutton Road, turns around comes back to Metasville Road, turns left, turns left on Prater Road, turns right on Aycock Norman Road, end of route. (PM): Reverse route

Delicia Ferguson - Bus #07-3 (AM): Begins on Midway Church Road/Hwy. 79, turns right on Hwy 79 at Midway Church Road picks up at Norman Road, turns left on Tabernacle Church Road, turns right on Deer Drive, turns right on Carpenter Drive, turns left on Deer Run Court, turns left on Tabernacle Church Road, turns left on Hwy. 79, turns right on Murray Creek Road (Providence Ferry), turns around comes back to Elberton Highway, turn left turns left onto Julia Drive, comes back out, turns left on Elberton Highway, turns left on Bethany Church Road, turns

left on Remsen Road, turns left on Biscayne Drive, right on Bayshore Drive, right on Karen Way, right on Remsen Road, comes back to Bethany Church Road, turns left, turns right on Iveytown Road, right at the end of Iveytown Road, to Hwy. 79 turns left on Prater Road turn left on Aycock- Norman turn right on Aycock Farm Road turn around right Aycock- Norman left on Metasville Road end of route comes to school (PM): Reverse route.
