

CSQG gets back down to work

After summer fun and vacations, it's time for the Classic South Quilt Guild (CSQG or Guild) to settle down and get back to work.

During the summer, there were a couple of workshops to get started on the Quilts of Valor (QOV) for veterans in the community. This year there will be 12 presented at a later date.

In the absence of president Debbie Sutton, president-elect Sandy Yarborough, called the meeting to order in Wesley Hall at Washington First United Methodist Church (WUFMC) on Liberty Street in Washington, Georgia. Fourteen of the 20 members were present. Everyone introduced themselves to those who may have been new to the Guild and after minutes from the May meeting and the treasurer's report were read and accepted as information, the meeting began in earnest.

The raffle quilt the Guild members have been working on will be given away Mule Day, October 9, at Callaway Plantation in Washington. The drawing will be at 3 p.m. It is a beautiful red/white/blue card trick pattern. During the festival, the members of the Guild will display antique quilts in the old schoolhouse on the property. There will also be hand quilters there demonstrating their craft. At the September meeting, Donna Taylor will present fabrics and pattern for the next raffle quilt.

A new Christmas challenge was presented. Each member is to bring 6 fat quarters (a piece of fabric measuring 18"x22") to the next meeting and they will be exchanged with another member who will then make something for the owner of the fabrics. The projects will be presented at the Christmas luncheon on December 17.

Each member was asked to make a name tag for herself. Dimensions were given and a pin was given each member to attach to her name tag so that at special occasions, and for projects made, a charm will be presented for display on their name tags. Donna Taylor was put in charge of that. She is also the card committee-making sure members get birthday cards and get well cards.

Doris Ranew and Norwood Strother were made in charge of refreshments and luncheons for the year.
