

Calli Nix, Carolyn Megow Bring Home Top Honors At Dee-Mack Meet

This is Coach Hamilton from Fieldcrest High School's track team. I just wanted to share some noteworthy results from last night's meet in Dee-Mack meet with you all:

Fieldcrest athletes Calli Nix and Carolyn Megow claimed some first and second place finishes at the Deer Creek-Mackinaw track meet.

Calli finished first in shot-put with a toss of 31feet, 5-inches (within a foot of the facility re-

cord) She is ranked 3rd in the conference.

Carolyn Megow had a 1st place in the 300 hurdles with a time of 52.75 seconds. She is ranked 2nd in conference!

Carolyn also placed 2nd place in discus with a throw of 79-feet, - 1 inch; and 2nd place in shot-put with a throw of 28-feet, 1 inch.

Girls in the 4 x 100, Aja Mesarchik, Kyra Cunningham, Kalla Burns, and Carol Megow finished in 2nd place with a time of 56.88.

College & Vaccinations

(From Toluca Front Page) to the president, said the school will not be requiring vaccinations for the fall semester.

"The university is strongly encouraging and recommending that all of our students and employees get vaccinated," Streb said. "At this point, we are not mandating it, but if you are not vaccinated you will be put into our weekly surveillance testing."

Streb said NIU will be using the SHIELD test developed at the University of Illinois, with results available within 24 hours.

The College of DuPage and College of Lake County have both released statements saying they will not require vaccines.

For now, the University of Illinois is not mandating that students get the vaccine. Chancellor Robert Jones told faculty members this spring that decisions about vaccine requirements will be made by the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Rachel Hatch, spokesperson at Illinois State University in Normal, said no decision has been made about whether vaccinations will be required for students in the fall.

"The university will follow guidelines from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the governor's office," said Hatch in a statement.

Southern Illinois University in Carbondale is also holding off on a decision.

"We still in the process of gathering information about vaccinations and testing. We will have more information available at a later time," SIU spokesperson Kim Rendfeld said in a statement.

With many colleges taking a wait-and-see approach to vaccine mandates, it could be difficult for new and returning students to know what to expect. In addition to checking with their individual colleges for their respective poli-

cies, students can find a list of colleges mandating vaccinations via the Chronicle of Higher Education.

Streb is hopeful the fall semester will be a return to normalcy. "We are reaching the end of the pandemic although we have a little ways to go, but we're certainly looking forward to having what looks like a more normal fall than certainly what we saw last fall," said Streb.
