CRIMINAL CHARGES

Catherine E. Sandoval, 48, charged with a Count 1, Class X felony in that in November 2020 she allegedly committed the offense of possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver in that said defendant knowingly possessed with the intent to deliver more than 15 grams but less than 100 grams of methamphetamine or a substance containing methamphetamine.

Catherine E. Sandoval, 48, charged with a Count 2, Class 3 felony in that in November 2020 she allegedly committed the offense of possession of methamphetamine in that said defendant knowingly possessed less than 5 grams of methamphetamine or a substance containing methamphetamine.

Thomas R. McGuire, 42, Mattoon, charged with a Count 1, Class 2 felony in that in September 2020 he allegedly committed the offense of delivery of methamphetamine in that said defendant knowingly delivered to another person less than 5 grams of methamphetamine or a substance containing methamphetamine.

Thomas R. McGuire, 42, Mattoon, charged with a Count 2, Class 2 felony in that in September 2020 he allegedly committed the offense of possession of methamphetamine in that said defendant knowingly possessed less than 5 grams of methamphetamine or a substance containing methamphetamine.

Christina M. Champagne, 43, Atwood, charged with a Count 1, Class 3 felony in that in December 2020 she allegedly committed the offense of possession of methamphetamine in that said defendant knowingly possessed less than 5 grams of methamphetamine or a substance containing methamphetamine.

Christina M. Champagne, 43, Atwood, charged with a Count 2, Class 3 felony in that in December 2020

she allegedly committed the offense of possession of drug paraphernalia in that said defendant knowingly possessed items of drug paraphernalia, being a red straw, with the intent of using it to ingest, inhale, or otherwise introduce a controlled substance into the human body.

Christina M. Champagne, 43, Atwood, charged with a Class 4 felony in that in December 2020 she allegedly committed the offense of driving while driver's license is revoked, in that said defendant drove a motor vehicle on a highway in the State of Illinois, at a time when her license or privilege to drive was revoked for a violation of Section 11-501 of this code; and for sentencing purposes, the subject have violated this section on one prior occasion.

John L. Troxtell, 51, Thomasboro, charged with a Class 4 felony in that in December 2020 he allegedly committed the offense of driving while driver's license is revoked, in that said defendant drove a motor vehicle on a highway in the State of Illinois, at a time when his license or privilege to drive was revoked as a result of a conviction for Driving Under the Influence; and for sentencing purposes, the subject have violated this section on at least two prior occasions.

Michelle M. Lopez Gonzalez, 48, Villa Grove, charged with a Count 2 Class A misdemeanor in that in December 2020 he allegedly committed the offense of unlawful interference with reporting domestic violence in that the said defendant, after having committed an act of domestic violence, attempted to prevent the victim from calling the 9-1-1 emergency telephone system in that said defendant grabbed the cell phone from their hands.

Lopez Gonzalez, 48, Villa Grove, charged with a Count 3 Class A misdemeanor in that in December 2020 he allegedly committed the offense of battery in that said defendant knowingly without legal justification and by any means made physical contact of an insulting nature to a victim, in that the defendant stuck the victim with his hands.

Tabitha A. Spracklen, 40, Arcola, charged with a Class A misdemeanor in that in September 2020 she allegedly committed the offense of theft in that said defendant knowingly obtained unauthorized control over property of another, said property being merchandise items including groceries,

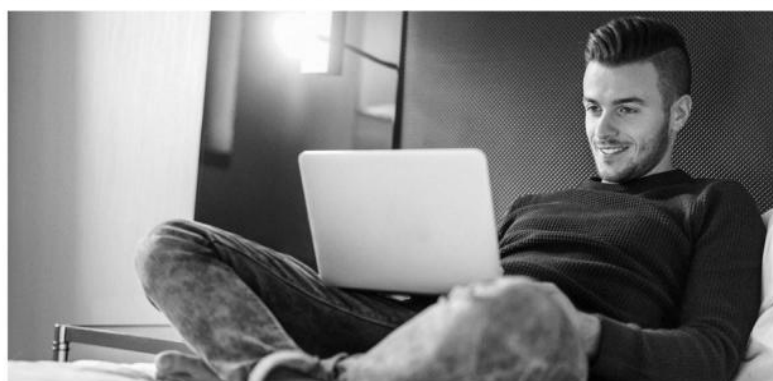
