A three-mile race open to the public will start at 7:30 a.m. at the school's Cross-Country Team Race Course. Anyone is welcome

to participate by running and/or walking. Following the open race, an invitation for local cross-country teams will begin.

The cost of the open race is \$25 per person and includes a T-shirt. Shirt sizes must be specified on the registration form. If you are unable to participate, or would

prefer to donate, you can do so by filling out a donation form. All proceeds will benefit the Horizon Health Doc Acklin Scholarship. The first scholarship was awarded in 2017. Since then, eight Paris Cooperative High School Seniors have been awarded \$1,000 each toward furthering their education in the

medical field.

The race is sponsored by Horizon Health Foundation of East Central Illinois and Paris High School in memory of the late Dr. James Acklin, who passed away August 23, 2015. He retired in 1994 after 34 years of service at Paris Community Hospital as a family physi-

cian.

Dr. Acklin was a respected member of the Paris High School cross country team that captured an unprecedented four consecutive state championships from 1946-49.
