CRIMINAL CHARGES

Luke T. Gard, 38, Tuscola, charged with a Count 1 Class 2 felony in that in September 2021 he allegedly committed the offense of aggravated driving under the influence of alcohol, in that the said defendant drove a motor

vehicle, at a time when he was under the influence of alcohol, in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-501(a)(2); and for sentencing purposes, the defendant having violated this Section or a similar provision on at least two previous occasions.

Luke T. Gard, 38, Tuscola, charged with a Count 2 Class 4 felony in that in September 2021 he allegedly committed the offense of aggravated unlawful use of a weapon, in that the said defendant possessed a pistol in a vehicle, at a time when said pistol was uncased, loaded, and immediately accessible, and said defendant has not been issued a currently valid license under the Firearm Concealed Carry Act.

Archie L. Pettigrew, 47, Urbana, charged with a Count 1 Class 4 felony in that in July 2021 he allegedly committed the offense of aggravated driving with an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more, in that said defendant drove a vehicle while the alcohol concentration in his blood or breath was 0.08 or more, in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-501(a)(1), and committed the violation at a time when he knew or should have known that the vehicle being driven was not covered by a liability insurance policy.

Archie L. Pettigrew, 47, Urbana, charged with a Count 2 Class 4 felony in that in July 2021 he allegedly committed the offense of aggravated driving under the influence of alcohol, in that said defendant drove a motor vehicle, at a time when he was under the influence of alcohol, in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-501(a)(2), and committed the violation at a time when he knew or should have known that the vehicle being driven was not covered by a liability insurance policy, is now in violation of 625 ILCS 5/11-501(d)(1)(1).
