ISBE has provided separately a preview of preliminary statelevel data only from those districts that opted to test in the spring. ISBE will release district- and school-level assessment data from spring testing on Dec. 2 and will release district- and schoollevel assessment data from fall testing, as well as final state-level assessment data,

on April 27, 2022.
