Westside has storied beginnings

Ms. Phenelope Bond was born in 1862, grew up in Brownsville. She met and married Leroy Shackelford in 1883. The Shackelfords then moved to Trenton, where he became a pharmacist and they had six kids.

Mrs. Shackelford saw a need for a school and Sunday school, so she consulted Mr. Phillips about using a log house in the mill yard. Phillips donated the old house and regular classes soon began.

As the Sunday school grew, Bro. H.A. Todd, then pastor of First Baptist Church, along with several others, constructed "The Little Brown Church." It was a school as well. During its first year, the church averaged 58 in attendance.

In 1954, under Dr. Paul Wieland, First Baptist voted to construct a new \$30,000 building. The Little Brown Church was adopted as a mission effort of First Baptist and became known as the First Baptist Extension.

The Little Brown (now white) Church grew as an evangelistic arm of First Baptist under the leadership of pastors Otis Smothers, Herman Jaco, Virgil Barr,

Bro. Parrish, Russell Crouse, Bill Affolter, James Britt, Don Farmer, Gerald Green, Johnny Somers, Gayle Alexander and Bro. Fred Mitchell. However, in July of 1966, Mitchell petitioned for First Baptist to become a self-supporting, independent church. His petition was granted, and the former Little Brown Church/First Baptist Extension was constituted as Westside Baptist Church.

In 1973, Bro. Bill Williams removed the church from First Baptist and constructed the educational wing and fellowship hall. This facility is still enjoyed by members of Westside today.
