






Coachable Moments ...

Next Level Wildcats ...


Two former Greene County Wildcats are continuing their playing careers this spring at the collegiate level. Mary Grace Turner, a 2017 graduate of GCHS, is a fifth-year senior in her third year at William Carey University. The former Wildcat catcher was a Southern States Athletic Conference (SSAC) All-Conference and Second Team All-Region selection a year ago after finishing with a .350 batting average, 21 extra base hits, and 40 RBI's. So far this season, Turner was named the SSAC Softball Player of the Week as the nationally-ranked Lady Crusaders went 4-0 for the week of Feb. 14-20. During that span, Turner hit .500 and slugged 1.167, while totaling six hits, five runs and eight RBIs. One of her four extra-base hits during that time was a walk-off grand slam over Xavier University.

Kenneth Moore, a 2019 graduate and former standout for Nick Chatham's Wildcats, is back on the field as well this year at Holmes Community College. Last season, Moore was the secondleading run producer for Holmes, driving in 21 runs, while batting .223. He belted 13 extra-base hits in 2021, including two homers. Moore is a starter on the infield for Holmes, who is off to a 3-5 start to the season.
