“If you can get through it without major injuries and your morale doesn’t drop, then it is much better than scheduling a weaker slate of games,” King said.

That makes sense, but there is also the threat, especially with such a young team, that too many setbacks can erode confidence more than it builds experience. King knows that preventing that could be the toughest part of the coaching job that lies ahead for he and his staff this year. But, right now, his confidence that his team will continue to develop and be battle-

tested and ready for region play remains high.

“We haven’t lost the kids, they are still with us and understand what we are trying to do,” King added. “I feel confident they will bounce back. Our kids are tough and they are competitors.”

“We have a young, talented group, that just needs more playing experience. And, there is just no way to simulate the game experience, which is the best teacher, even when the lessons are tough pills to swallow.”

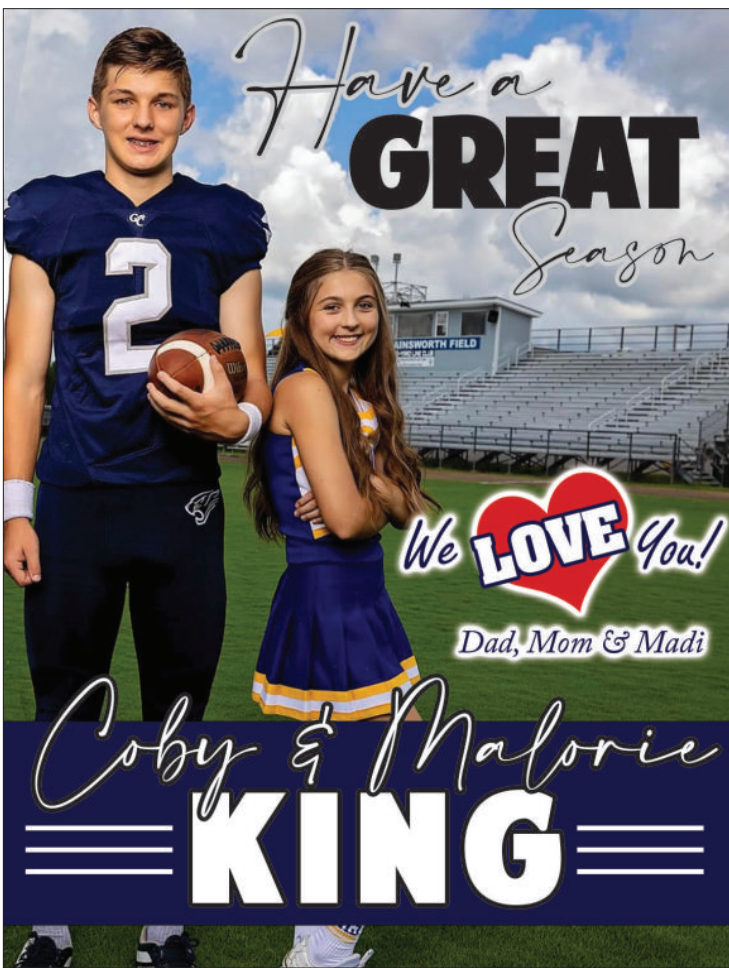
