

Tipsy Island a low-key option for frozen margaritas and more

Tipsy Island Margarita Lounge, located at 1615 South Mustang Road Suite D in Yukon, provides a more relaxed atmosphere to enjoy good company and tasty drinks.

Tipsy Island is open Tuesday through Thursday 2 p.m. to 10 p.m., Friday and Saturday 2 p.m. to 2 a.m., and Sunday 2 p.m. to 10 p.m.

The Lounge opened up in November 2020. Opening up knee-deep in a pandemic may have limited clientele for a while, but it gave owner/operator Tammy Radney and her family a chance to turn the location into what they wanted.

"It was kind of a good time for us, because we never closed," Radney said.

"It was nice. We had time to actually build it."

Radney is a real estate agent, and began opening Tipsy Island as a kind of hobby.

"I'm a luxury real estate broker here in the Mustang/Yukon area, and my husband, he's also in real estate, and he said I needed to get a hobby. I thought what goes better with real estate than margaritas, we're always out having happy hour. I thought I'll just open up a little Margarita shop, right beside my brokerage, and we'll see how it goes. That's how we got into it."

Tipsy Island provides a more relaxed atmosphere for people not so suited by a standard bar.

"We are really low-key," Radney said Tuesday. "It's for older people to come in, have a few drinks, and go home. We close at 10

p.m. during the week, so we don't consider ourselves a bar. It's more of a lounge. We don't play loud music. It's made for those who just want to go in and have a conversation over a drink and go home, not to go get drunk and go crazy. It's definitely not that type of bar."

There is no food to order at Tipsy island, but there are restaurants nearby, and the staff is comfortable with customers bringing in a little snack.

"We have a lot of people who just do Uber Eats too," Radney said. "But most of the time, it's the pizza place, right down the strip here. Anybody who wants to come and just have a chill evening, we also have to-go margaritas and we have four different sizes. We have up to twelve flavors on tap, and it's real alcohol. It's not wine-based.

A lot of places around here are wine-based. Ours is real alcohol. You could get top shelf tequila off or top shelf whiskeys in there."
