On 17 June 2022 in Charleston SC, ETN3 Michael Murray graduated the third and final stage of the US Navy Nuclear Program. The US Navy Nuclear Program is one of the most academically challenging programs in the military. The training program consists of three stages: 1) six months of intensive classroom instruction in electronics at Nuclear Field Class "A" school; 2) six months of intensive classroom instruction in mathematics, physics, and basic engineering sciences at Nuclear Power School; and 3) six months of rigorous operational training and qualification on a nuclear reactor prototype plant. Nuclear Field personnel must demonstrate good academic performance in all phases of training. Michael was promoted to ETN3 (E-4) after gradu-



ating the first stage Class "A" school. He will soon be reporting for submarine duty. Michael is a 2020 graduate of Harrah High School, and is the son of Navy Veterans Mark and Julie Murray.
