Governor's Safety and Health Award Winners Announced

More than 20 companies have earned Governor's Safety and Health Awards for demonstrating an outstanding commitment to workplace safety, the Kentucky Labor Cabinet announced. "If the last couple of

years have taught us anything, it's that the power of example is incredibly important," Gov. Beshear said. "Being out there doing the right thing – even if others aren't - is a powerful message to other people out there."

During his keynote address at the event, the Governor commended employers in attendance for not just focusing on efficiency in the workplace but also for looking out for the safety of workers fueling the state's record-breaking economy. He also signed a proclamation declaring May 9-12, 2022, Safety and Health in the Workplace Week in the commonwealth.

"Protecting our folks on the job – it's a part

of our faith; it's part of our values; it's a part of looking out for everyone and living that very simple lesson that everybody counts," Gov. Beshear said. "Every single person has value. Everyone is a child of God, and when we commit to safety, I think we live out that faith and those values."

For more than three decades, the Kentucky Labor Cabinet and Kentucky Safety and Health Network, Inc., have partnered to host the annual conference. The event provides privatesector employers an opportunity to attend technical training on a myriad of workplace safety topics and engage with safety and health specialists.

"When we look at the statistics, especially year over year, you can see everybody's hard work," the Governor said. "There are many fewer injuries than if we go back five, six, eight years ago – that means we are all learning, and we're learning together."

The fiscal year 2020

rate was 3.2 cases per 100 full-time equivalent workers. Fiscal year 2021 data shows the commonwealth's rate has remained essentially unchanged at 3.3.

For comparison, Kentucky's rate in 1996 was 8.4.

"No matter where you work in the commonwealth, every Kentuckian has the right to be safe and to earn a living they can raise their family on,' Gov. Beshear said. "And everyone should feel confident knowing their employer is working just as hard every day to improve safety in every single way.'
