Hart County Historical Society

Hart County is an area as rich in history as it is culture.

For history buffs and anyone curious about the community, the Hart County Historical Society is the place to visit.

Established in 1968, the Society consists of a museum where Native American displays and Civil War relics can be viewed. A genealogy library is also available, as well as a small gift shop.

Battle for the Bridge Preserve in Munfordville is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is a stop on the American Battlefield

Heritage sites, the John Hunt Morgan in KY Heritage Trail, and the US 31W-31E Heritage Corridor. The Battles for the Bridge Historic sites in Hart County can also be found listed on the National Register of Historic places.
