MARTECH ONLINE ENTRIES

We are going to continue to do early entries and hope you can try the online entry system at the website address below:

The online system will be up for you to register until Friday, July 1, 2022. We recommend that you use your full name to login and your last name as your password. The online entry system can be used for ALL open class exhibits. Even if you have been an exhibitor other years, you need to register online to add entries.

There are several advantages to doing your entries online. You will not have to wait in line as long when you bring your exhibit in and if you have your entries submitted by Friday, July 1, 2022, there will be no entry fees. Remember that everyone who enters an exhibit in the fair is eligible for a ribbon. All blue ribbon exhibits are automatically entered in eligible for Best of Show, Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons.

If you submit your entries early, your name will be printed on your tags and they will be ready for you when you arrive. You can still bring changes with you on the day of the fair, but we will have to wait for these tags to be printed. There is no late entry allowed for the Horse Division.

We hope this process will make it easier for people to enter. Remember, there is **NO ENTRY FEE** for anything if it is entered by July 1, 2022. If you have questions, call the division superintendent, Missy 218-526-0489 or Kalli 218-843-1713 (may also send a text).
