Number one seed Lakers begin District Tournament

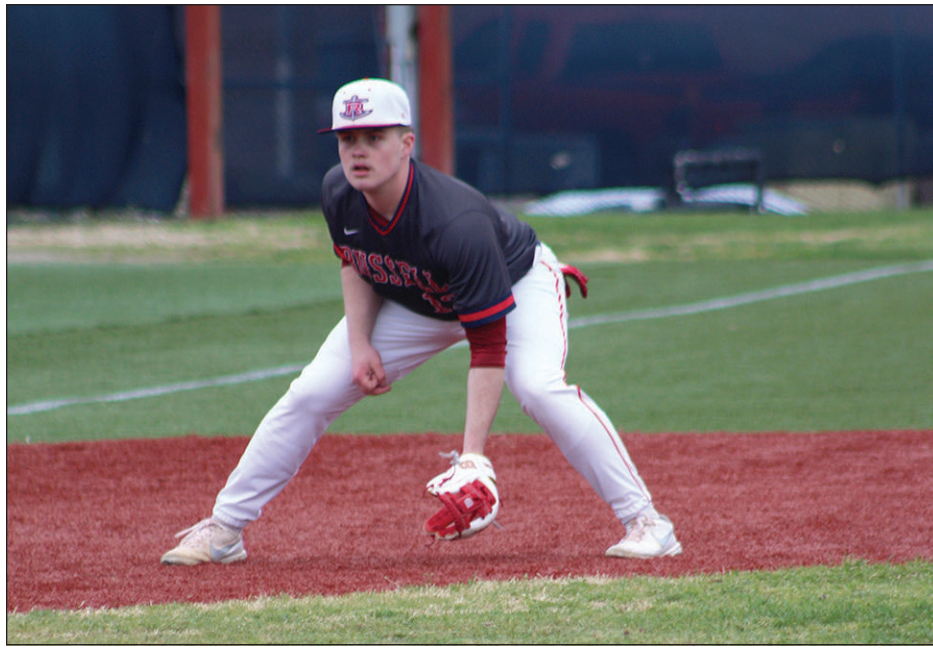
The Lakers wrapped up another busy week last week heading into District Play this week.

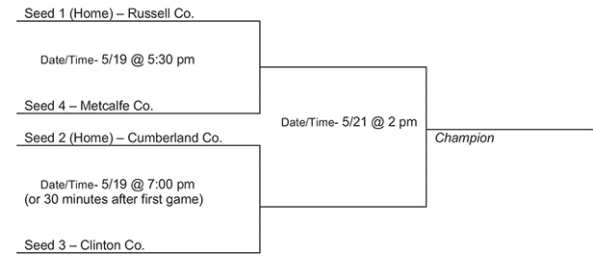

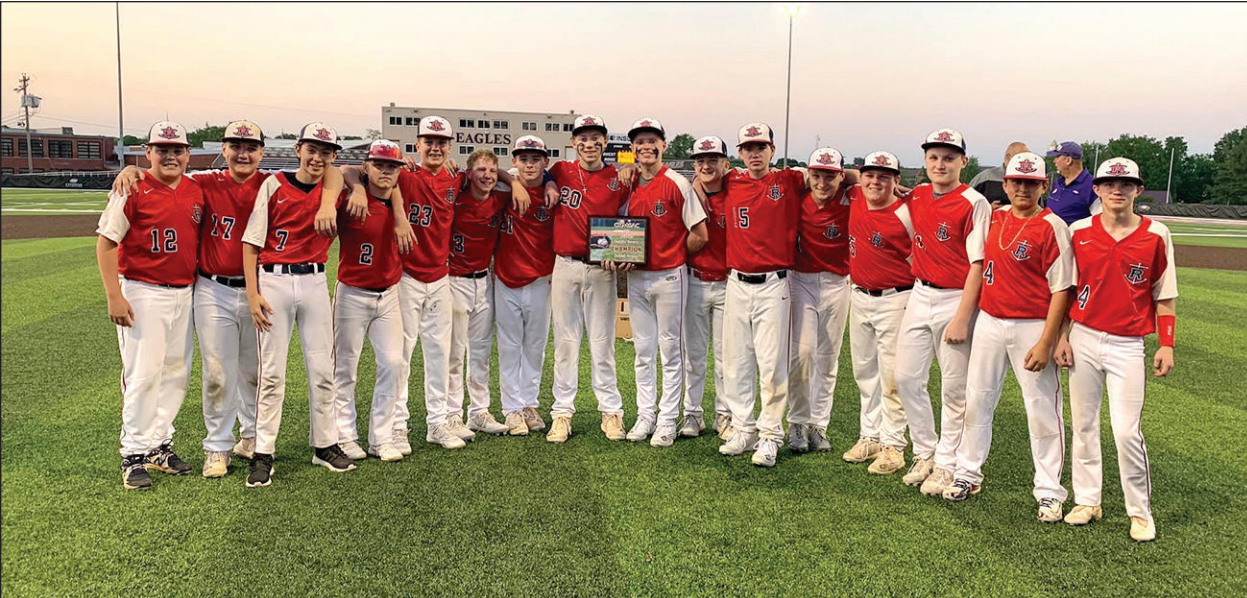

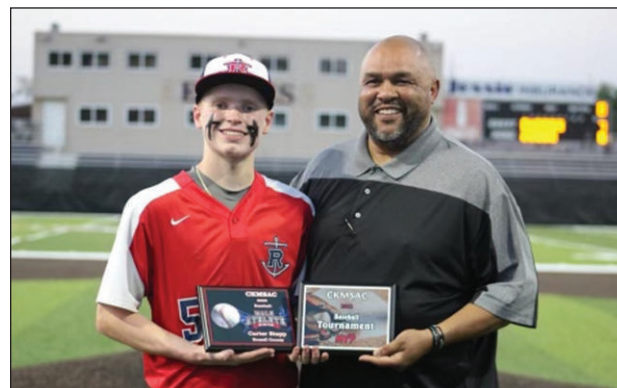

RCMS Lakers Tournament Champions

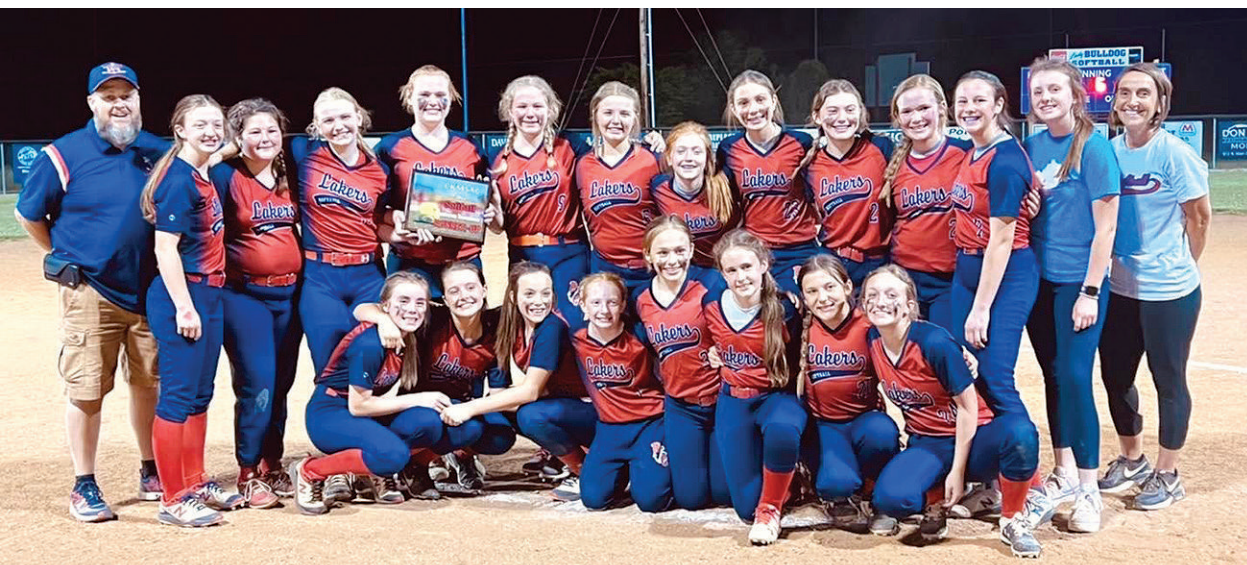
