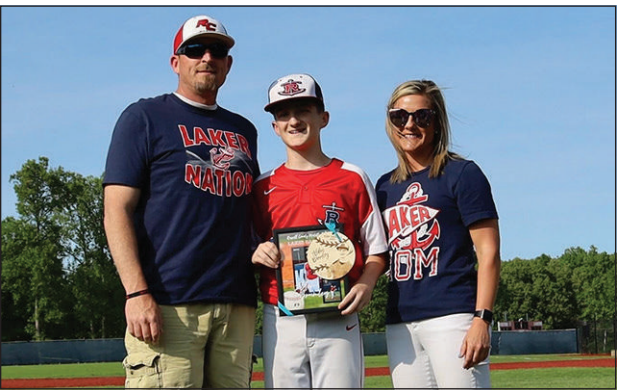


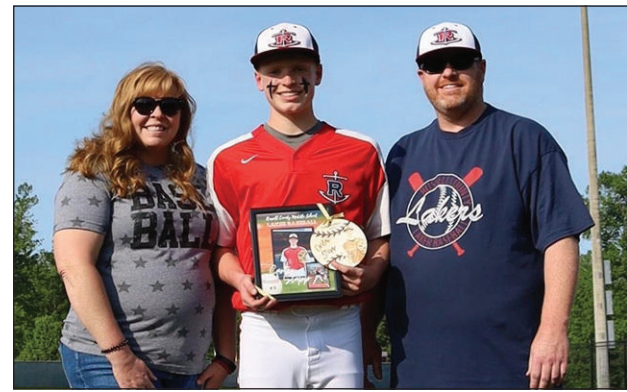

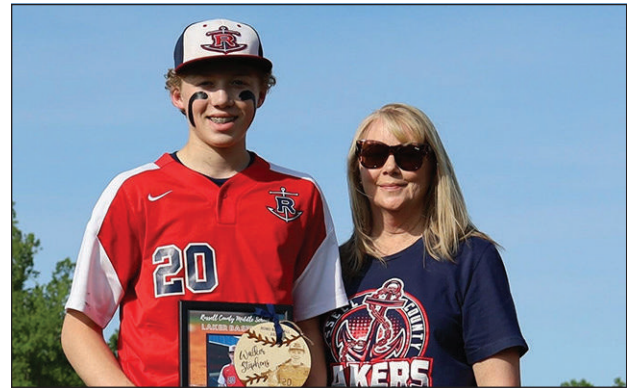

SOCCKER SALUTE

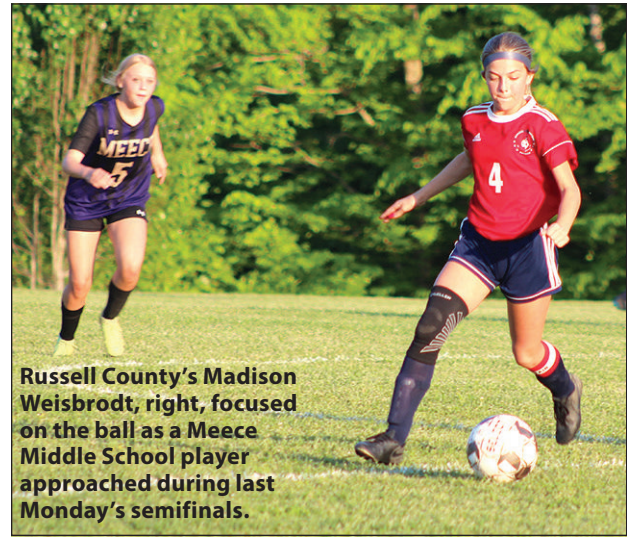
