**The Russell County School District** will be participating in the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program. As part of these programs, **Russell County High School, Russell County Middle School, Russell Springs Elementary, Jamestown Elementary and Salem Elementary** will offer **healthy meals** every school day at **NO COST** to the students due to the implementation of the **Community Eligibility Provision** for school year **2022-2023**. Students will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a household application. However, an income verification form is still required for other federal programs.
