ORDINANCE NO. 2022-05

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX ON REAL, PROPERTY, MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTOR BOATS AND OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR CITY PURPOSES IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL SPRINGS, KENTUCKY FOR THE YEAR 2022

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL SPRINGS, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I: An ad valorem tax as set forth herein below is hereby levied on all lands, improvements and personal property, tangible and intangible, held or owned by any person, firm, company, corporation or association in his, her, their or its name or as fiduciary or agent and subject to taxation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including all property and franchises heretofore and hereinafter assessed by the Russell County Property Valuation Administrator.

SECTION II: Motor Vehicles and Motorboats
An ad valorem tax rate of \$.1700 cents on each \$100 (one hundred dollars) of assessed valuation of motor vehicles and motorboats subject to taxation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky is hereby levied for city purposes.

Section III: Real Property
An ad valorem tax rate of \$.1610 cents on each \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) of assessed valuation of real property subject to taxation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky is hereby levied for city purposes.

Section IV: Other Personal Property
An ad valorem tax rate of \$.1610 cents on each \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) of assessed valuation of personal property subject to taxation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky is hereby levied for city purposes.

Section V: All of such taxes above shall be paid to the City Clerk/Treasurer and shall be due and collectible by December 31, 2022. All taxes received by November 30, 2022, will receive a 2% discount, and all taxpayers whose taxes are not paid on or before December 31, 2022, shall be deemed delinquent, and shall pay in addition to the amount of taxes due a penalty of twelve (12%) percent and said penalty shall be collected in the same manners as the taxes due. Further, all delinquent taxes will be published in the local newspaper as "Delinquent Taxes".

Section VI: The City shall not mail out a property tax bill that has an amount due of \$5.00 (five dollars) or less.


Section VII: The City Clerk/Treasurer is hereby authorized to collect said taxes and penalties.


Section VIII: The ad valorem tax is levied for the purpose of paying officers and employees of the City of Russell Springs, expenses of the Fire Department, Police Department, Street Maintenance and Improvements, construction as well as the current expenses of the City and shall be paid into the General Fund of the City.

Section IX: The Russell County Assessment of Property situated within the City of Russell Springs is hereby adopted as the City Assessment for the City Ad Valorem Taxes for the year of 2022.

Section X: Any unpaid tax as herein provided for shall remain a lien against the property in favor of the City of Russell Springs until paid.

Section XI: The Ordinance becomes effective upon adoption and publication according to law.
