TEAM 60 - AWARDS BANQUET



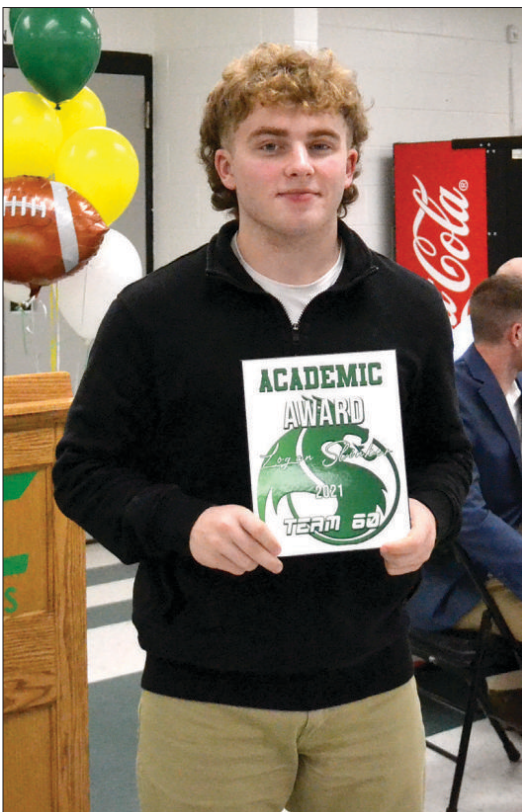
