RECOMMENDED SAFETY TIPS FOR FIREWORKS

- Never allow young children to handle fireworks
- •Older children should use them only under close adult supervision
- Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol
- Anyone using fireworks or standing nearby should wear protective eyewear
- Never hold lighted fireworks in your hands
- Never light them indoors
- •Only use them away from people, houses and flammable material
- Never point or throw fireworks at another person
- •Only light one device at a time and maintain a safe distance after lighting
- Never ignite devices in a container
- •Do not try to re-light or handle malfunctioning fireworks
- Soak both spent and unused fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding
- •Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish fireworks that don't go off
